



Oh my goodness, y'all...**THIS IS SO**

GOOD! Like, crazy delicious good. In my not-so-humble and always-correct opinion, this is way better than your typical cinnamon roll.



Ingredients

cooking spray 2 cans (12.4 oz each) Pillsbury® refrigerated cinnamon rolls with icing • 4

½ c. heavy ground cinnamon

2 tsps vanilla

whipping cream • 2 tsps

 $\frac{1}{2}$ c. chopped pecans (you can use more or less according to your liking) • $\frac{1}{4}$ c. maple syrup

directions

Preheat oven to 375°F. Spray a 13×9-inch (3-quart) glass baking dish with cooking spray.

Separate both cans of dough into 16 rolls; set icing aside. Cut each roll into 8 pieces; place pieces in dish.

In a medium bowl, beat eggs. Beat in cream, cinnamon and vanilla until well blended; gently pour over roll pieces. Sprinkle with pecans; drizzle with syrup.

Bake 20 to 25 minutes or until golden brown. Cool 15 minutes. Meanwhile, remove covers from icing; microwave 10 to 15 seconds or until thin enough to drizzle.

- 1 ounce Iced Coffee
- 1 Cinnamon Stick

preparation

Add Baileys Irish Cream, Zacapa Rum, Allspice Dram, and iced coffee to a cocktail shaker full of ice. Shake vigorously until chill ed. Strain over fresh ice into a rocks glass.
