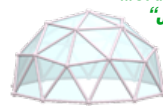

Holy Cow! Cinnamon Roll

Oh my goodness, y'all... **THIS IS SO GOOD!** Like, crazy delicious good. In my not-so-humble and always-correct opinion, this is way better than your typical cinnamon roll.



Ingredients

cooking spray
2 cans (12.4 oz each)
Pillsbury®
refrigerated
cinnamon rolls
with icing • 4
½ c. heavy
ground cinnamon

eggs
whipping cream • 2 tps
2 tps vanilla
½ c. chopped pecans (you can use more or less according to your liking) • ¼ c. maple syrup

directions:

Preheat oven to 375°F. Spray a 13×9-inch (3-quart) glass baking dish with cooking spray.
Separate both cans of dough into 16 rolls; set icing aside. Cut each roll into 8 pieces; place pieces in dish.
In a medium bowl, beat eggs. Beat in cream, cinnamon and vanilla until well blended; gently pour over roll pieces. Sprinkle with pecans; drizzle with syrup.
Bake 20 to 25 minutes or until golden brown. Cool 15 minutes.
Meanwhile, remove covers from icing; microwave 10 to 15 seconds or until thin enough to drizzle.

Baileys Independence


What's unique about this drink was the fact that it includes both allspice dram and iced coffee. Explore the somewhat odd flavor combination and this one really works. Also in the Baileys Independence on Ice is **Zacapa Rum** and, as the name indicates, **Baileys Irish Cream**.

ingredients

1 ounce Baileys Irish Cream with a hint of Caramel
1/2 ounce Zacapa Rum
1/4 ounce Allspice Dram
1 ounce Iced Coffee
1 Cinnamon Stick

preparation

Add Baileys Irish Cream, Zacapa Rum, Allspice Dram, and iced coffee to a cocktail shaker full of ice. Shake vigorously until chilled. Strain over fresh ice into a rocks glass.

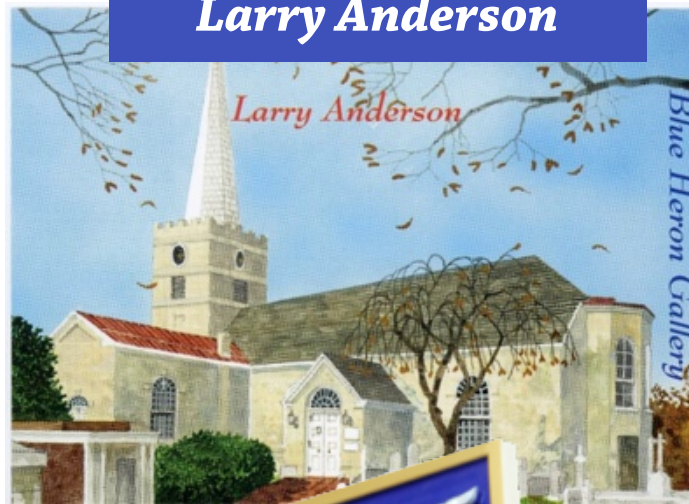

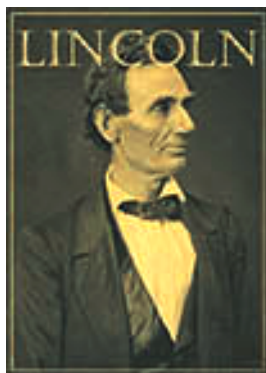
