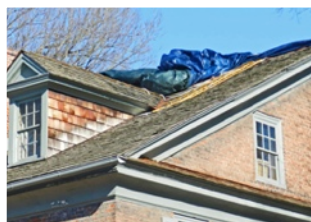

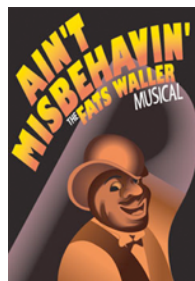

Maryland Crab Imperial



Go to the market...

- 1 lb jumbo lump crabmeat (or lump)
- ½ cup mayonnaise
- 1 tsp sugar
- 1 heaping tsp old bay
- 1 tsp finely chopped Italian parsley
- 1 large egg lightly beaten
- squeeze of lemon juice



Roll up your sleeves

Mix the mayo, egg, sugar, old bay, lemon juice and parsley together and blend well,

this is your **imperial sauce**.

Gently fold crabmeat into imperial sauce, being **careful** not to break up crab meat. Place portions in baking dish using ramekins or small prep bowls. Bake in 350° oven for 20 minutes (top will turn golden brown) Allow to cool just a few minutes before serving, it will set and be more flavorful as it cools ever so slightly.

Monkey Gland

It may have a funny name and you might get some strange when ordering it, but the Monkey Gland is a cocktail everyone should try at least once. It's an interestingly flavored Martini that is good with any of the absinthe substitutes but much better with the original.

- 2 oz your best gin please
 - 1 oz orange juice sans pulp
 - 1/4 oz grenadine
 - 1 dash absinthe
 - orange slice for garnish
1. Pour the ingredients into a cocktail shaker with ice cubes.
 2. Shake well.
 3. Strain into a chilled cocktail glass.
 4. Garnish with the orange slice.

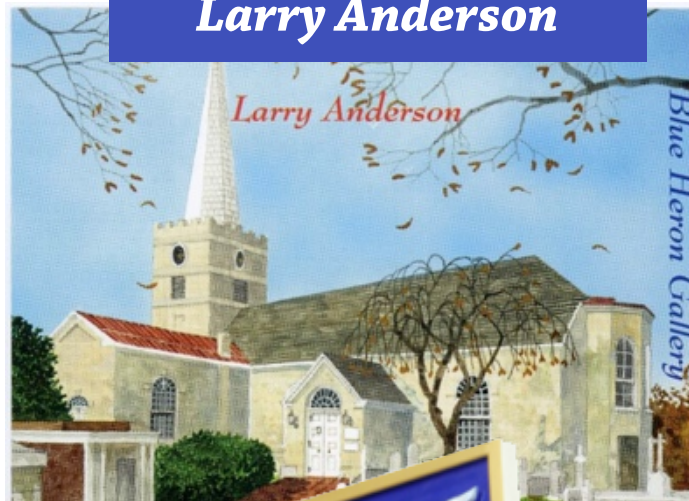
