

Buckeye Cookies



The gooey peanut butter center in these cookies is to die for

For the Filling 1 1/4 c. creamy peanut butter - 1/3 c. powdered sugar **For the Cookies** 3/4 c. (1 1/2 sticks) butter, softened - 3/4 c. packed brown sugar - 1/2 c. granulated sugar, plus more for rolling - 1 large egg - 1 tsp. pure vanilla extract - 1 1/4 c. -purpose flour - 3/4 c. cocoa powder - 3/4 tsp. baking soda 3/4 tsp. kosher salt

- 1. Make oven happy at 350° and line two large baking sheets with parchment paper. Make filling: In a medium bowl, combine peanut butter and powdered sugar and mix until smooth. Using a 2-teaspoon cookie scoop, scoop into 22 small balls and freeze until hardened, 30 minutes.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine butter, brown sugar, and sugar and beat until light and fluffy, then add egg and vanilla and mix until evenly combined. Add the flour, cocoa powder, baking soda, and salt and mix until evenly combined.
- 3. Scoop a heaping tablespoon of the cookie dough and flatten into a pancakelike circle on the baking sheet. Place a frozen peanut butter ball on top. Bring the edges of the dough around the peanut butter ball and pinch the edges together to seal, adding more dough if necessary to cover the frozen peanut butter completely.
- 4. Roll stuffed cookie dough ball in sugar and place back on prepared baking sheets. Repeat until all dough is used, spacing the cookies about 2" apart.
- 5. Bake until the cookies are set, about 12 minutes. Serve warm or at room temperature. WATCH THE VIDEO

 Place chocolate in a large bowl set over a bain marie or in a double boiler at a low simmer. Stir chocolate until melted. Turn off the heat and let stand.

• Remove the chocolate from the bain marie and using a whisk, fold in the egg whites all at once. When the whites are almost completely incorporated, fold in the whipped cream. 


