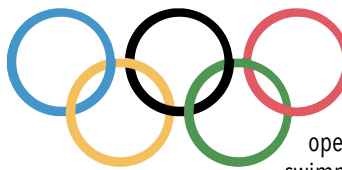

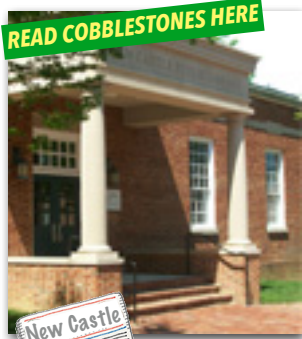

## on the counter

- 1 lb. penne - 4 tbsp. unsalted butter - 2 cloves garlic, minced - 3 tbsp. flour - 4 c. chicken broth - 1 c. heavy cream - kosher salt - Freshly ground black pepper - 1 tsp. mustard powder - 2 c. shredded rotisserie chicken - 1 c. thick-cut ham, chopped - 2 c. shredded Gruyere - 1/2 c. grated Parmesan - 1 tbsp. fresh parsley, chopped

## let's make dinner

1. Make oven happy 400°.
2. In a large pot of salted boiling water, cook pasta according to package directions until al dente. Drain and set aside.
3. In a large skillet over medium heat, melt butter. Add garlic and cook until fragrant, about 2 minutes. Sprinkle in flour and cook until slightly golden, 2 minutes more. Pour in chicken broth and heavy cream and bring to a boil. Season with salt and pepper, then add mustard powder. Reduce heat to medium-low and simmer until liquid coats the back of a spoon, 10-12 minutes.
4. Remove skillet from heat and stir in cooked pasta, chicken, ham, and Gruyere. Sprinkle top with Parmesan.
5. Bake until warmed through, 13-15 minutes. For a golden top, broil for an extra 2-3 minutes. Garnish with parsley.



## Picon Punch

- 1 1/2 oz Amer Picon\*
- 1/4 oz Grenadine
- Soda water, to top
- 1/2 oz Brandy

### make the punch

Float the brandy on top. Garnish with a lemon peel.

\*Amer Picon: Because it's not available in the U.S., as a substitute, combine 2 parts [Ramazzotti](#) amaro, 2 parts dry curaçao and 1 part gentian liqueur in an airtight bottle and shake. Refrigerate until ready to use

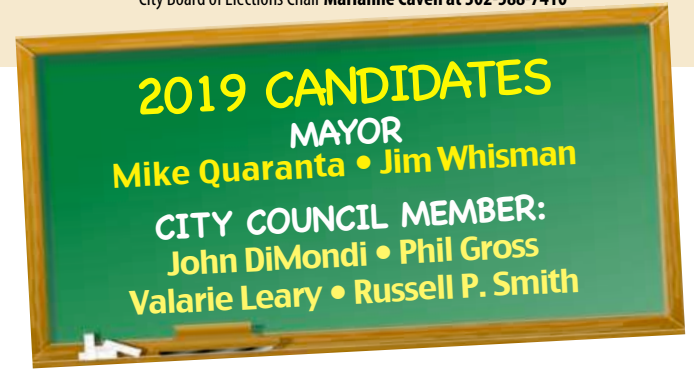

### Crossing the Delaware



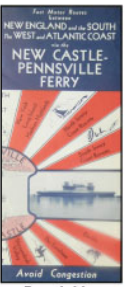
In this postcard, the *Pittsburgh*, acquired from the Pennsylvania Railroad, still wears the Tuscan Red color of the "Pennsy."

The Delaware River, a mighty highway of commerce, has also been a formidable barrier to travel. Ferries operated sporadically from New Castle from very early days. Modern ferry service didn't begin until 1925 to meet the increasing needs of automobile traffic. Eventually, eight ferries operated. Service abruptly halted in August of 1951 with the opening of the much-anticipated Delaware Memorial Bridge.



The ferries first operated from a Delaware Street terminal. Heavy demand required the addition of the Chestnut Street terminal shown above.

The *New York*, built by Pusey & Jones in Wilmington, made its first run on May 19, 1941. Its twin, the *New Jersey* soon followed.

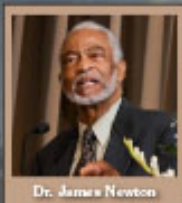

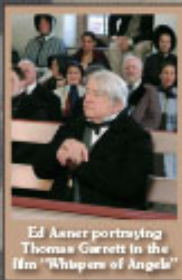
