**11 Robert Fulton** patents the steamboat. 1809, The term "gerrymandering" had its beginning when Mass. governor, Elbridge Gerry, signed a redistricting law that favored his party. 1812, **Bernadette Soubirous**, claimed to have seen a vision of the Virgin Mary near Lourdes. 1858, **Cher** recorded **Bang Bang**. 1966 **Diana Crump** becomes first US woman jockey to ride against men at **Hialeah**. 1969

**12 Women** in the Utah Territory win the right to vote. 1870, **Frederick W. Thayer** patented the baseball catcher's mask. 1878, **Calvin Coolidge**, known by many as the 'Silent President', made the first presidential political speech on radio. 1924, The radio play **The Adventures of Superman** debuted. 1940

# Chocolate Mousse



## Ingredients

5 1/4 ozs  
bittersweet  
chocolate,  
coarsely  
chopped  
♥ 14 ozs cold  
heavy cream ♥ 3 lg  
egg whites ♥ 1oz  
sugar Sweetened  
whipped cream, for  
garnish, optional ♥ Shaved  
chocolate, for garnish, optional

## Directions

♥ Place chocolate in a large bowl set over a bain marie or in a double boiler at a low simmer. Stir chocolate until melted. Turn off the heat and let stand.

♥ Beat the cream over ice until it forms soft peaks. Set aside and hold at room temperature. With a mixer, whip egg to soft peaks. Gradually add the sugar and continue whipping until firm.

♥ Remove the chocolate from the bain marie and using a whisk, fold in the egg whites all at once. When the whites are almost completely incorporated, fold in the whipped cream. Cover the mousse and refrigerate for approximately 1 hour or until set. Serve in goblets topped with more whipped cream and shaved chocolate, if desired. Recipe courtesy of Bobby Flay

# Rose Pomegranate Martini



*In a cocktail shaker filled with ice, combine the following ingredients:*

1 1/2 oz pomegranate juice, 1 1/2 oz vodka infused with white rose tea (recipe follows), 1/2 oz sweet vermouth, 1 dash each of cherry bitters and aromatic bitters, and 3-5 broken mint leaves. Shake, and pour into a cocktail glass garnished with rose petal confetti. To infuse the vodka, pour 1 cup vodka into a container, and add 1 bag Numi Organic White Rose Tea. Seal the container, and let sit for a few hours or overnight in a cool dark place.
