After hosting the Kalmar Nyckel for almost twenty years, Lewes can no longer accommodate the ship due to a build up of silt that would require a 3 million dollar dredging project to correct. The Kalmar Nyckel Foundation and the DRBA say they have no funding for a project of that magnitude.

This should be a red flag for our City. In addition to much needed infrastructure projects, funding for dredging should be a factor for future budgets.

The foundation will continue to offer public sails in Wilmington and Historic New Castle in 2019 as well as onboard crew training programs this spring and summer.

New Toll Rates



EZ-Pass discount for passenger car/small truck "home agency" users (NJ EZ-Pass or DelDOT account holders) of 25 cents off the new \$5 toll rate.

Frequent Traveler discount rate increases from \$1.25 to \$1.75. On 1/1/2021, the rate increases to \$2.25. Frequent Traveler program is 20 trips in 90 calendar days. Delaware River and Bay Authority (DRBA) Five Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) is amended from \$423M to \$399M. Implementation date deferred for two months from March 1 to May 1, 2019.

Let's us cook southern

chicken fried steak



on the counter

1 1/2 cups plus 2 tbsp all purpose flour - 1/2 tsp freshly ground black pepper - 8 (4 oz) tenderized (have butcher run them through cubing machine) beef round steaks - 1 tsp Paula Deen's House Seasoning (1 cup salt - 1/4 cup black pepper - 1/4 cup garlic powder) 1 tsp seasoning salt - 3/4 cup vegetable oil - 1 1/2 tsp salt 4 cups hot water - 1/2 tsp optional MSG - 1 bunch or 1 medium yellow onion, sliced green onions

let's make yummy

Combine 1 1/2 cups flour and 1/4 tsp of pepper in a small bowl. Sprinkle 1 side of the meat with the House Seasoning and the other side with the seasoning salt, and then dredge the meat in the flour mixture. Heat 1/2 cup oil in a large heavy skillet over medium-high heat. Add 2 or 4 of the steaks to the hot oil, and fry until browned, about 5-6 minutes per side. Remove each steak to a paper towel-lined plate to drain. Repeat with the remaining steaks, adding up to 1/4 cup more oil, as needed.

Make the gravy by adding the 2 tbsp remaining flour to the pan drippings, scraping the bottom with a wooden spoon. Stir in the remaining 1/4 tsp pepper, and the salt. Reduce the heat to medium and cook, stirring frequently, until the flour is medium brown and the mixture is bubbly. Slowly add the water and the MSG, if using, stirring constantly. Return the steaks to the skillet and bring to a boil over medium-high heat. Reduce the heat to low, and place the onions on top of the steaks. Cover the pan, and let simmer for 30 minutes.

Boiling water, to fill a mug

4 Cloves - 1 Lemon peel or wheel - 2 tsp Demerara sugar or brown sugar - 1/4 oz Fresh lemon juice - 2 oz Bourbon, rye whiskey, Irish whiskey or scotch. Fill a mug with boiling water and let stand for a minute or two to warm.

Meanwhile, stick the cloves into the lemon peel or wheel and set aside. Empty the mug and fill about halfway with fresh boiling water. Add the sugar and stir to dissolve. Add the prepared lemon peel or wheel and stir. Add the lemon juice

and whiskey, and stir again.

Much of the land remains agricultural, and the Ellerslie Mansion was home to F. Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald from 1927 to 1929 was demolished in 1973.

There was once an entire town called Edgemoor Village, built in 1871 by the

Edgemoor Iron Company to house the workers and their families. When the company closed, the entire village was demolished, including three rows of brick homes, a couple of stores, a church, and the Edgemoor School.
