**24** The **Supreme Court** ruled itself to be the final interpreter of all constitutional issues. 1803, **Los Angeles Vineyard Society** was organized. 1857, The first parade to use floats occurred in New Orleans at **Mardi Gras**. 1868, Civil War soldier **Joshua Chamberlain** dies. He was the last Civil War veteran to die as a result of wounds from the war and considered by some the last casualty of the war. 1914, **Du Pont** begins commercial production of nylon toothbrush bristles. 1938, **The Beach Boys** recorded **Help Me Rhonda**. 1965 **25** **Edward Willet** displayed the first trained monkey act. 1751, First **cabinet meeting** (at George Washington's home) 1793, **Samuel Colt** patents the revolver. 1836, **16th Amendment** was ratified. It authorized a graduated income tax. 1913, **Ty Cobb**, one of the legends of baseball, issued an edict to his team, the **Detroit Tigers**, that forbid players to play the game of golf during training camp.
