## good signs ahead



### WHEN YOUR FRIENDS COME TO VISIT NEW CASTLE,

it's often necessary to give them step-by-step instructions to to guide them into town. Our signage is often confusing, or sometimes non-existent, but now things are about to change. Thanks to the **Historic New Castle Alliance** and **DELDOT** new signs are on their way.

Five large "Historic New Castle" signs will be installed on state highways at Routes 13, 273, 141 and 9 South leading into town. In addition, there will be a smaller sign directing Route 273 visitors towards Delaware Street. The New Castle Planning Commission approved sign placement on February 25<sup>th</sup>. DelDOT expects to fabricate and install the signage by April.

The signs are funded by the Historic New Castle Alliance through a Community Economic Development Grant the organization obtained through New Castle County in 2012.

# RumChata cupcakes

(Yield: 24 cupcakes, batter is thick)



## RumChata Cream Cheese Frosting

NOTE: This makes A LOT of frosting. I tend to use quite a bit on my cupcakes. I ended up with a cup extra. So, if you don't use a lot, cut the recipe in half. (I also normally freeze my leftover

frosting for use later. I label and date it, I've used some that's been frozen for just about 5 months and it tasted fine)

## ingredients

1/2 c. butter (1 stick, at room temperature)  
1 1/2 c. sugar  
2 c. flour  
2 tsp baking powder  
1/2 tsp salt  
1 c. RumChata  
1 tsp vanilla extract  
1 tsp cinnamon  
4 egg whites

## directions

Preheat oven to 350°  
Combine sugar & butter and beat until fluffy  
Mix together flour, baking powder, salt, & cinnamon, set aside  
Mix the RumChata & vanilla together, set aside  
Alternating, add in the flour mixture and RumChata mixture in to the butter and sugar. Start and end with the flour mixture.  
In a clean mixing bowl, beat egg whites until soft peaks form (this will be easiest in an electric mixer)  
Fold egg whites in to the batter - do not do this in an electric mixer, use a spatula  
Fill cupcake liners  
Bake for 20 minutes or until cake "bounces back" when touched.

## ingredients

12 ounces of cream cheese (1 1/2 packages, at room temperature)  
1/2 cup of butter (1 stick, at room temperature)  
1/2 tsp of vanilla  
5 tbsp of RumChata  
1 pkg of confectioners' sugar (2 lb. bag)

## directions

Note: The frosting is pretty sweet. I had some people say it was just enough, others said it was a little too much. It is REALLY tasty, so of course I was in favor of having more of it.  
Combine butter and cream cheese until smooth  
Add vanilla  
Slowly add confectioners' sugar  
Mix in RumChata (use more or less based on the thickness of the frosting. I often find that some days I would use 5 tbsp, some I would use 4)  
Frost the cupcakes  
I would recommend refrigerating the cupcakes if you won't be serving them right away. If it's warm, the frosting can melt. Enjoy!

Mystery **CobbleConsult** suggests you might try replacing the vanilla extract & cinnamon with a 1/4 cup of additional Rum Chata & for the icing replacing the 1/2 tsp of vanilla with another tbsp. of RumChata.

# IRISH BLOND IRISH BUCK

## A modern classic

With Saint Patrick's day next week, this is the best time of year to enjoy a cocktail with Irish whiskey. Dale DeGross, America's "King of the Cocktail" and perhaps the person most responsible for the recent renaissance in American cocktails has created sophisticated, elegant way to enjoy Irish whiskey with the Irish Blond cocktail. Featuring Michael Collins Irish whiskey and the sweetness of orange curacao touched with the light flavor of fino sherry before being finished off with a flamed orange zest, this has quickly become one of my favorite cocktails to make and enjoy.

## Ingredients:

- 2 oz. [Michael Collins Irish Whiskey](#)
- 3/4 oz. orange curacao
- 1/4 oz. Fino sherry
- 1 dash of [orange bitters](#)

1. Add first four ingredients to a [mixing glass](#).
2. Add ice to mixing glass. [Stir](#) to chill and strain into a chilled [martini glass](#).
3. Garnish with a flamed orange peel expressed over the cocktail.

## Whiskey and Ginger Ale Cocktail

The Buck "cocktail family" is defined by having a base spirit, ginger ale or ginger beer and citrus (*generally in the form of a lime squeeze*). The Dark and Stormy and Moscow Mule are both classic examples of the Buck family With the Bushmills Irish Buck, the sweet and smooth taste of Irish whiskey is paired with the spice notes of ginger and just a touch of acid from the lime squeeze. This cocktail is easy to make at home and any bartender worth his or her salt should also be able to make you a Bushmills Irish Buck without any trouble.

## Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 ounces [Bushmills Irish Whiskey](#)
- 1/4 ounce Fresh Lime Juice
- 2 ounces [Ginger Ale](#)

## Preparation:

1. Combine Bushmills and Lime Juice over ice in a [Collins glass](#).
2. Top with ginger ale or ginger beer.
3. Garnish with a [lime wheel](#).

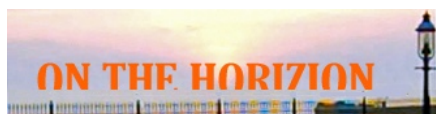
