

2 lbs ground beef -1 cup bread crumbs - 1 egg, beaten - 1 cup milk - ½ cup BBQ Sauce - 1 tsp salt - ½ tsp black pepper - 1/2 tsp garlic powder - 3-4 med/large yellow onions - 1 package of Bacon and Additional BBQ Sauce for dipping

Ready? In a large bowl, combine the ground beef, crumbs, egg, milk, 1/2 cup BBQ, onion, salt, pepper and garlic powder.

³ Cut top and bottom off onion, cut in half and peel off skin. Then separate the onion into "layers." Use the larger outside lavers.

⁹ Stuff your meatball mix between two Onion Layers (essentially making an onion seal around a large meatball).

⁵ Wrap each "bomb" with 3 slices bacon and secure with toothpicks.

February highlights:


Patrol recovers a **stolen motor vehicle** in the Farmers Market parking lot.

Patrol responded to **twenty accidents** in the month of February.


