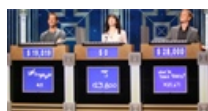

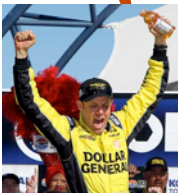

## BARBECUE BISCUITS

### Let's make these!

Dump a lb of ground beef into a pan and start browning it. Ground beef is so versatile and very friendly. It's pretty yummy too!

While the beef is browning, let's make the sauce. Again, nothing fancy,

this is just homemade sloppy joe sauce. You can't go wrong with sloppy joe sauce. Mix your sauce together and dump it into the pan of cooked ground beef and let it simmer for about 10 minutes. **Told ya this was simple.**

| • 2 tablespoons brown sugar   | • 1 can refrigerated biscuit dough (regular sized biscuits, 10 total) |
| • 2 tsps Worcestershire sauce | • grated cheddar cheese, for topping                                  |
| • 2 tsps prepared mustard     |   |

While the meat is simmering, grab your muffin tin. I always use regular sized muffins, but you can use a mini muffin tin.

Grab a can of refrigerator biscuit dough and roll each biscuit into a ball. Flatten it out and press it into the muffin tins so that you have a little bowl shape. If you are using a mini muffin tin, use a half biscuit for each muffin.

Spoon as much as will fit into each biscuit and bake at 375° for about 10 minutes. You can bake a little longer and they'll get a bit crunchy. **Now put 'em on a tray and serve with pride!**

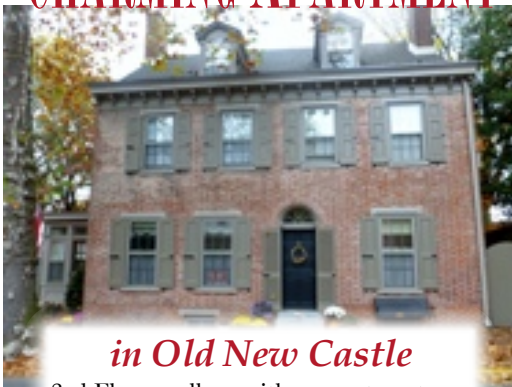
