"Separation Day (June 15), the observance of the stirring action on that date in 1776 when the Colonial Assembly meeting here in the old State (Court) House—then the provincial—took the bold step to declare Delaware (The Three Lower Counties—on—the-Delaware) free and separate from Great Britain, and also the proprietorship of the Penns."

So wrote Nick McIntire in *Behind The Times* column in his New Castle Gazette.

Fast forward to this calendar year as we prepare to celebrate 240 years of not being Pennsylvania. Or as Senator Tom Carper likes to say "we divorced Pennsylvania."

This year's two-day celebration again begins with the Friday night beer garden, music and about a dozen food trucks to satisfy everyone's palate. Meanwhile, on Friday, in addition to the traditional Separation Day events, Battery Park will swell with nearly 40 plus trucks bearing the preparations for Saturdays inaugural ► **Colonial BBQ Competition**. A new sensation for our town!

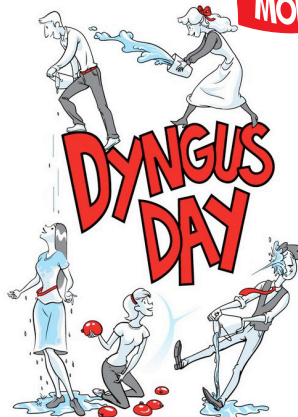

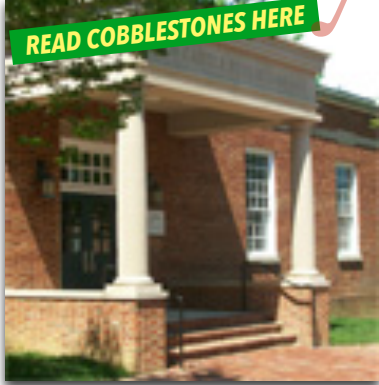

now follow this...

Preheat the oven to 350°

Spread the pecans on a baking sheet and bake until lightly toasted, about 8 minutes; set aside.

Melt 1 stick butter in a medium saucepan over medium heat. Add the brown sugar and heavy cream; boil until slightly thickened, about 4 minutes. Stir in the vanilla, vinegar, rum, salt and the toasted pecans. Pour all but 1/2 cup of the pecan mixture into an 8-inch-round, 3-inch-deep cake pan. Refrigerate until almost set, about 15 minutes. Set the remaining pecan mixture aside at room temperature.

Put the remaining 1/2 stick butter in a microwave-safe bowl; microwave until melted. Put the granulated sugar in another bowl. Pinch off tablespoon size of dough and roll into 1-inch balls. Dip the balls in the melted butter, letting the excess drip off, then roll in the granulated sugar; arrange in the prepared cake pan in 2 layers, leaving a bit of space between the balls. Let rise, uncovered, in a warm place until doubled in size, about 1 hour, 30 minutes.

Preheat the oven to 350°. Bake the bread until puffed and golden brown (a thermometer inserted into the center should register 175°, about 55 minutes; tent with aluminum foil if the top is getting too dark. Remove the bread from the oven and spread the reserved 1/2 cup pecan mixture on top.

Transfer to a rack and let cool 10 minutes in the pan, then invert onto a plate.

Pull off pieces to serve **and enjoy!**

- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1½ sticks unsalted butter
- 1 cup packed light brown sugar
- ¾ cup heavy cream
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 tsp apple cider vinegar
- 2 tbsps dark rum
- 1/8 tsp kosher salt
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 1 batch Basic Sweet-Roll Dough, without nutmeg

This drink combines not one but two guilty pleasures: it's a mashup of a Rum and Coke and a Kahlúa and Milk

There is no shame in drinking this guilty pleasure.

1.5 oz White rum

.5 oz Kahlua

1.5 oz Milk

3 oz Cola

Add all the ingredients to a highball glass filled with ice.

Garnish with mint leaves if desired.

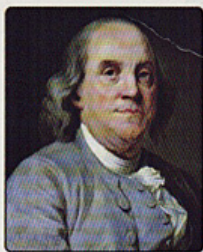

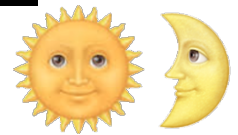

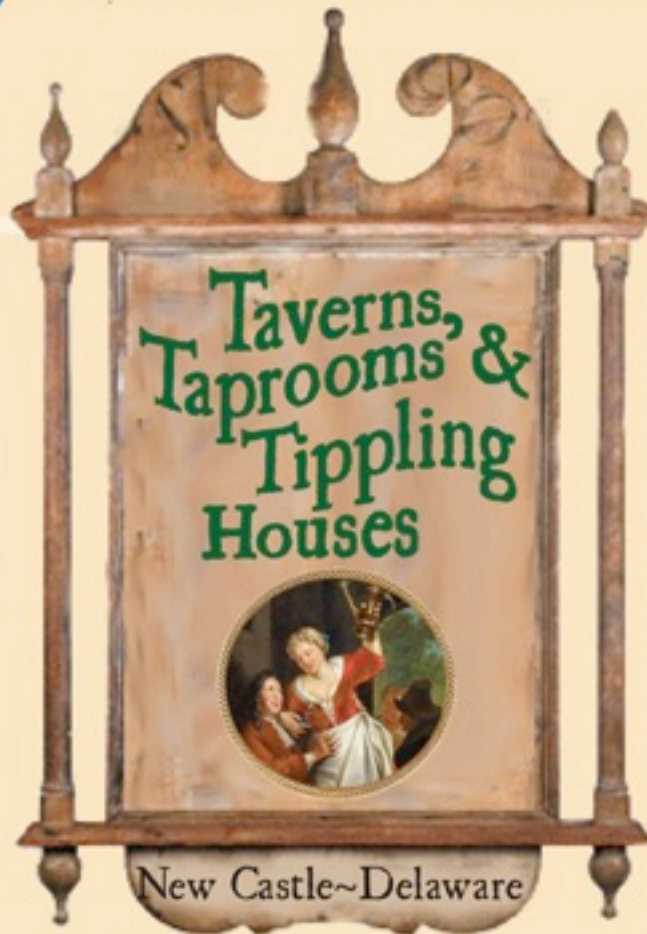
