This will work with any good cookie cutter dough. If you want to try something other than the chocolate-chip cookie recipe, but I would definitely recommend this chocolate chip cookie recipe. 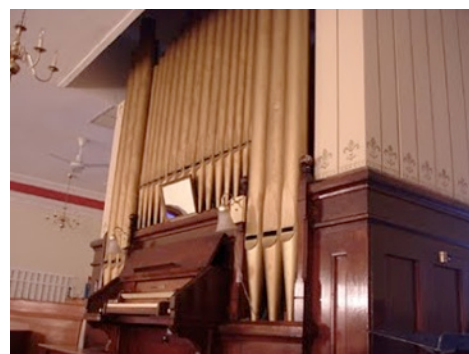

The New Castle City Police launched a new volunteers program in 2006 called V.I.P.S. (Volunteers in Police Service) and are searching for additional New Castle citizens interested in becoming VIPs members. The focus of the program, which is mainly funded by a Delaware Emergency Management Citizen Corps. grant, will be to allow and enable the citizens within the corporate limits of New Castle City to be involved in the non-confrontational aspects and functions of the day to day and special event operations of the New Castle Police department. It will also enable the volunteers to become part of the law enforcement solution to some of the problems they may be experiencing in their own communities in New Castle.

Some of the duties they will be performing are: Writing parking warnings, identifying abandoned vehicles, traffic control, house and business checks, Megan's Law sex offender notifications, residential and commercial patrol, assisting disabled motorists, clerical work, victim assistance and other duties authorized by the Department. Volunteers will be required to reside within the corporate limits of the City of New Castle, be citizens of the United States, in good physical and mental health, possess a high school diploma or its' equivalent, be at least 21 years of age and successfully pass a background investigation.
