

Pier construction to commence



The firm of Dissen & Juhn of Stevensville, MD was the low bidder Thursday at the bid opening for the long anticipated pier at the foot of Delaware Street.

A fixed dock along the river will allow visiting vessels to tie-up and residents to enjoy. The pier will extend from the Delaware Street Wharf approximately 170 feet to the navigable channel.

Included is a fixed 100 foot long dock, access causeway, access ramp and stairs. The construction will involve mobilization / demobilization; installation of driven piles; erection of steel framing and wood decking; construction of concrete ramps; and placement of miscellaneous railings, security gates, and dock mechanical facilities. Construction could begin as soon as July.





1 whole-wheat English muffin, split 1 small tomato, seeded and diced 1 tsp extra-virgin olive oil 1 thin slice (1/2 oz) Canadian bacon, diced 1/4 cup shredded part-skim mozzarella cheese Chopped fresh basil, for garnish

the how to do

Preheat the oven to 450°

Line a small baking sheet with foil. Place the English muffin halves cut-side up on the baking sheet. Top each with tomato and drizzle with the olive oil. Sprinkle the Canadian bacon over the tomatoes, then top with the mozzarella. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes, or until the cheese is melted and beginning to brown. Sprinkle with basil.


Hi world, *Peanut Butter* here.




