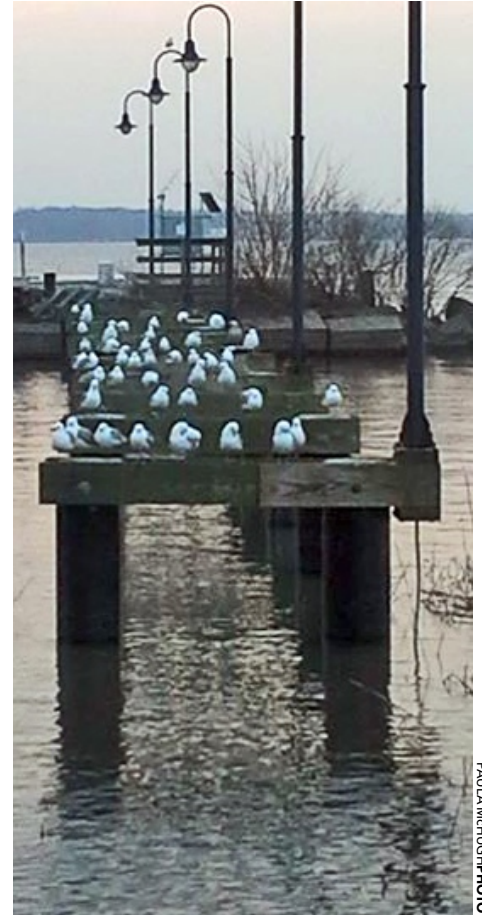

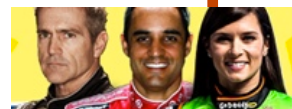

Yes friends and neighbors... it's **National Grilled Cheese Month**, and if you're a red-blooded American, this festive celebration inspires feelings of ecstasy. Feelings of passion. And feelings of carnal desire. What? It doesn't? We hear Cuba's nice this time of year, comrade.

Let's try some of these different approaches.

✓ **Mayonnaise** in place of the butter makes the bread toast evenly and gives a similar yet different crispiness. Gotta be the real stuff. Low or no fat mayo (*what's up with that stuff anyway*) has added sugar and water that will alter the taste and crispiness.

✓ This one's **baked** so it's easy to make more than 1 at a time. The cheese oozes out of the sandwiches while baking and becomes a crunchy crust around the bread. Use a really good bread and slice it extra thick. You can use commercial mango chutney or try this home-made version: Mango Chutney. Pops...too much work for a sandwich, buy a jar at the market.


✓ Here a different mixture to use with **Texas Toast** or french bread.
3 ounces cream cheese, softened - ½ c mayonnaise - 2 c cheddar cheese, shredded - 2 c mozzarella cheese, shredded - ½ tsp garlic powder - ½ tsp seasoning salt - ¼ tsp cracked black pepper - 12 slices
Texas toast thick bread

✓ **A white pizza** inspired GC with taleggio, fresh ricotta, basil, spinach, BACON, and some red pepper flaked olive oil all on a sliced focaccia loaf.

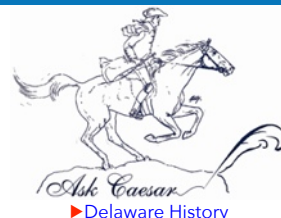

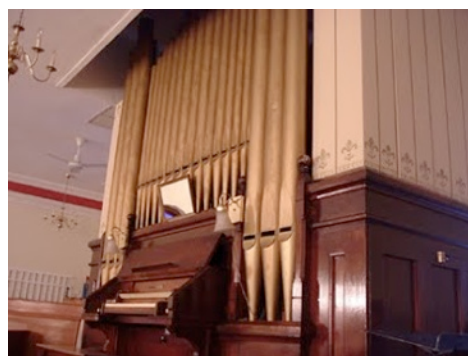
