**28** A mutiny on the *Bounty* took place when a rebel crew took the ship and set sail to Pitcairn Island. The mutineers left *Captain W. Bligh* and 18 sailors adrift. 1789, The first organized *night baseball game* was played in Independence, Kansas. 1930, A vaccine against *yellow fever* was announced 1932, *Arthur Godfrey* was seen for the last time in the final broadcast of *Arthur Godfrey and His Friends* 1959

**29** *Jesse James* gang robs bank in Columbia KY (1 dead/\$1,500). 1872, *Electric arc lights* were used for the first time, in Cleveland. 1879, *Charlie Reilly* is baseball's first pinch hitter. 1892, *Gideon Sundback* patents the zipper. 1913, *Aretha Franklin* releases *Respect* 1967, *Steve Carlton*, Phillies pitcher, became the first left hander in the major leagues to get 3,000 career strikeouts. 1981

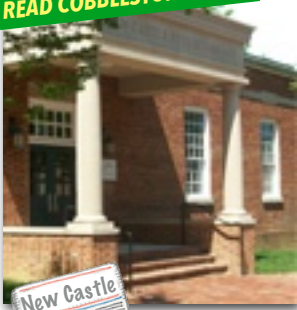

# LET'S JAM JAM JAM



*Good biscuits* deserve a homemade jam and  
this is the perfect one. It keeps for about 2  
weeks in the fridge and goes great in yogurt  
or on muffins too

## all ya need is

2 lb.strawberries, halved • 1 c granulated sugar • 2 tbsp.lemon juice  
Pinch kosher salt

## easy steps

- In a large bowl, smash strawberries with a potato masher until coarsely crushed.
- In a large pot over medium heat, add strawberries, sugar, lemon juice, and a pinch of salt. Bring to a boil and cook until thickened and bubbles completely cover surface, 20 minutes. Let cool, then pour into a jar with a tight fitting lid and store in the refrigerator.
- Jam will keep stored in the refrigerator for up to 2 weeks.

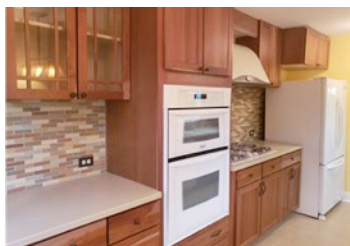
