Irish TV group filming in New Castle

Imagine Media Productions, an Irish TV company from Belfast, filmed a segment last Wednesday, for a historical documentary for BBC Northern Ireland. It's about

the Ulsterman Charles Thomson, one of the founding fathers of America. Thomson, the Scots-Irish Secretary of the Continental Congress who got his start in New Castle.

Filming started in the morning in Battery Park then moved to Amstel House & Dutch House locations.

Thomson was born in County Londonderry, Ireland, to Scots-Irish parents. After the death of his mother in 1739, his father emigrated to the British colonies in America with Charles and two or three brothers. The father died at sea, and the penniless boys were separated in America. Charles was cared for by a blacksmith in New Castle. ▶ *Charles Thomson, Prime Minister" of the United States".*

LIGHTS OUT?

Our traffic light at 6th & Delaware Streets is 36 years old and that's reason enough for DelDOT to deem just it another antique in New Castle and needs to be replaced.



4- way signs or flashing lights were mentioned. The report presented by DelDOT last Thursday had one major flaw. It didn't include any data from the summer months when 6th Street is favored by beach traffic traveling to Rt. 9 south. New traffic signals and equipment (and possible right of way of private property) would start at \$300,000, a cost possibly shared with the City. DelDOT favors the 4-way stop signs with crosswalks on 6th Street. (Crosswalks on Delaware Street would be considered). Councils concerns included the volume of traffic during the summer, increasing National Park visitors, special events, children safety. Additional studies and new reconitions later this year. **It's going to happen...just not now.**

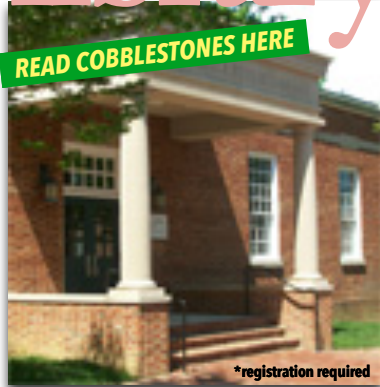

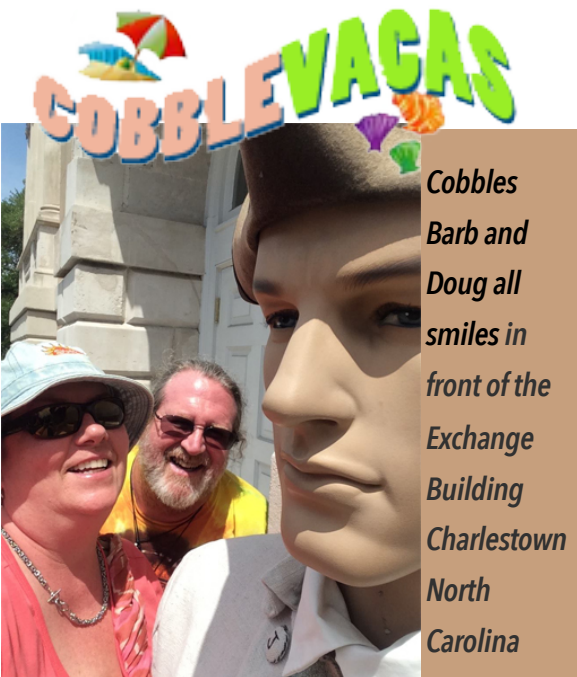

Bees need very shallow water to drink from.

However, shallow water evaporates quickly. Birdbaths are not the best option as bees tend to drown if the water is not be shallow enough. As for river and lakes, bees risk their lives trying to get water in the presence of fishes, frogs, and other wildlife, not to mention the risk of being swept away in water currents.

To help hydrate our little pollinators, set up a water feeder by filling a pie pan with marbles (spent wine corks) and then water. The marbles or corks give the bees a spot to land so that they don't drown when they come to drink. No more drowned bees!

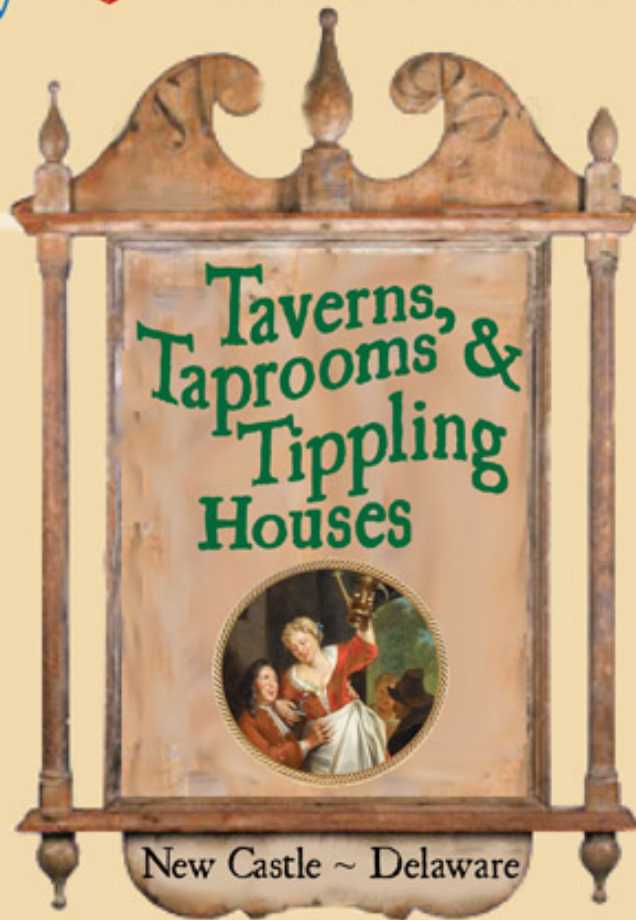
