Separation Day plans are set



The City of New Castle reports that the festivities for Historic New Castle's biggest weekend get underway on Friday, June 8, with an Opening Party (6-9:30pm) in Courthouse Square featuring Big Package, a 10-piece funk/soul/R&B band. There will also be craft beer and food trucks with bartender tips benefitting New Castle's Minquadales and Goodwill volunteer fire departments. Admission is free and the block party set-up in front of the historic New Castle Court House will provide an ideal setting for the evening. On Saturday, June 9, the Separation Day Parade will march down the streets of historic New Castle beginning at 11am. The parade is known for being one of the most charming and entertaining parades in Delaware. Re-enactors, bands, dance teams, classic cars, sports teams, mascots and a string band participate in this judged parade, which proceeds along Delaware Street into Courthouse Square.

Immediately following the parade, the Colonial BBQ Competition and Separation Day Festival get underway in Battery Park. This year's festivities will feature one open footprint for the combined event. Gates open at noon, so come on in for great live music, arts & crafts, vendors, kids' rides and attractions. BBQ and chicken wings will be for sale. In addition, New Castle-based nonprofits will be offering a wide variety of food and drink items such as hamburgers, hot dogs, sausage and peppers, funnel cake and more.

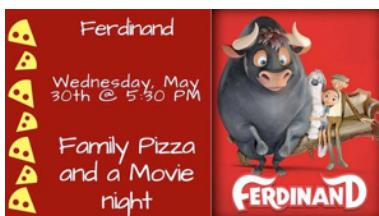

2 large baguettes, cut into 1-inch cubes 1/2 c. extra-virgin olive oil, divided 3 tbsp. red wine vinegar 1 tsp. honey kosher salt & freshly ground black pepper 1 large, seedless cucumber, roughly chopped 2 pt. cherry tomatoes (preferably multi-colored), halved 1 red onion, chopped 1 clove garlic, minced 1 bunch basil, torn

- Pre-heat a large skillet over medium-high heat.
- Meanwhile, in a large bowl, toss bread with 1/4 cup olive oil. Add bread to skillet and toast until golden and crisp, about 10 minutes. Drain and set aside to cool.
- Make dressing** In a small bowl, whisk together red wine vinegar, remaining 1/4 cup olive oil and honey. Season with salt and pepper.
- To large bowl**, add crispy bread, cucumber, tomatoes, onion and garlic. Toss with dressing until evenly coated and season with more salt and pepper.
- Garnish** with basil and serve.

...the first Norman Rockwell Saturday Evening Post cover was published on May 20, 1916.

Entitled *Boy with Baby Carriage*, it shows 2 boys in baseball uniforms scoffing at another boy dressed in his Sunday suit pushing a baby carriage. One of Norman Rockwell's favorite models, Billy Paine, posed for all three boys.

It was an instant success, and Norman Rockwell was on his way to becoming a household name.

He was paid \$75.00 each for his two paintings. \$150.00 in 1916 dollars would be \$3,447.88 in 2018 dollars. Quite a sum for a virtually unknown 18 year old artist!

say "summer" like no other plant. American natives, sunflowers are grown for beauty and harvested for seed.

An annual plant, sunflowers have big, daisy-like flower faces of bright yellow petals (and occasionally red) and brown centers that ripen into heavy heads filled with seeds.

Tall and coarse, the plants have creeping or tuberous roots and large, bristly leaves. Some sunflowers grow to over 16 feet in height, though there are also varieties today that have been developed for small spaces and containers. Most sunflowers are remarkably tough and easy to grow as long as the soil is not waterlogged. Most are heat- and drought-tolerant. They make excellent cut flowers and many are attractive to bees and birds.

Important terms to keep in mind when shopping for LED lights.

The retail price of LED light bulbs has dropped roughly 90 percent since their early days. LEDs use 80 to 90 percent less electricity than incandescent bulbs and last for years, saving you big cash and trips up the ladder. But know your terms.

Replacement wattage: It's the wattage of the incandescent bulb that the LED is meant to replace – a rough brightness equivalency.

Wattage: This is the actual power used by the LED bulb. A typical household LED uses about 8 to 20 watts, so if a fixture says 60W max, you have plenty of capacity to spare.

Lumens: It's the real measure of brightness. The more lumens per watt, the more energy efficient the bulb is.



CCT: Correlated color temperature is measured in kelvins (K) and describes the tone of light emitted. In general, use "warm" or "soft" white bulbs (3,000K or below) for bedrooms and living rooms; "cool" white (3,100 to 4,500K) for bathrooms; and "daylight" (above 4,600K) for outdoors or workrooms.

Dimmable: An LED bulb will work with a dimmer switch only if the package explicitly says so.
