The Happening List, the most happening Peoples' Choice contest in North Delaware, awarded New Castle's Dutch House the museum of the year!

Announcing the award with executive director Mike Connolly is Colleen Smarr and Lauren Spinelli of the NCHS staff. The Dutch House originates from the late 17th century in New Castle, and constitutes one of the oldest houses in Delaware. This original house continues to exist as the structural system of the house, beneath a Federal period "skin," or renovations that transformed the look of the house to what we see today. The Dutch House's mystique has intrigued visitors and townspeople alike for three centuries. Visit to the

anke for three centuries. Visit to the seafaring days of the late 17th century when New Castle was a young port. Enjoy the gleam of early pewter set at a hutch table. Discover the kas (an unusual cupboard), spoon rack, 1714 Bible, among the captivating Dutch Colonial artifacts which reflect the traditions and lifestyle in early America.

## **MSC receives State recognition**

MSC's Water Department was recognized for outstanding dedication and commitment and awarded the 2014 *Water/Wastewater Professional Team Award* by the State of Delaware House of Representatives. The award was presented at the Delaware Technical Community College Owens Campus among fellow water and waste water professionals. Each MSC water operator, **Greg Spiess, Tom Brewster** and **Barry Granger** was named individually under the leadership of Supervisor **Jay Guyer** and Assistant Supervisor **Ryan Jaeger** for demonstrating outstanding technical excellence and exemplary work ethic contributing to the high level of water quality in Delaware.

The MSC team successfully installed a temporary carbon filtration system and assisted in the design of the permanent system during 2014, among many other projects. The operators construct, maintain and repair the water system and are all fully licensed with special endorsements. Previous Commission President Robert S. Appleby attended the award ceremony and was glad to see the Department was recognized for all their efforts in providing safe drinking water to the citizens of New Castle City.




changed by President Truman in 1945. The

new flag used the same basic design for the eagle, except (in response to some heraldic criticisms) changed the eagle to face towards its right (the direction of honor) and thus towards the olive branch, and the eagle was changed to be in full color. Instead of the four stars, a circular ring of 48 stars was added around the eagle.

The only changes have been to add more stars for new states.




