## Separation Day In Historic New Castle, Delaware

### Grand Marshall



WILLIAM T. QUILLEN

The Honorable William T. Quillen will be the 2014 Separation Day Grand Marshall. Judge Quillen was a former Delaware Supreme Court Justice and Secretary of State. In 2013, he received the Governor's Heritage Award for being the driving force behind the planning of the present Archives building in Dover.

Over the years, Judge Quillen has served as Superior Court Judge, Chancellor of the Chancery Court, and Supreme Court Justice. He has practice law in a private practice, taught law at Widener University, and written about the history of the Delaware Court of Chancery.

Judge Quillen, a long-time resident of New Castle, has been involved in the preservation of New Castle's historic legacy, including service as a former Vice President and Director of the New Castle Historical Society. He is highly regarded for his work in preserving Delaware history.

# Strawberry Salad



with Balsamic-Cardamom Dressing

## Ingredients

- 3 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
- 2 tablespoons agave nectar or honey
- Miniscule pinch of ground cardamom (*It's strong stuff!*)
- Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper
- 1 pound strawberries, hulled and quartered
- 1 pint blackberries
- 1 large sprig mint, leaves roughly torn

## Directions

Whisk the balsamic vinegar, agave nectar, cardamom, a pinch of salt and a few generous grinds of pepper in a medium bowl. Tumble in the strawberries and blackberries, sprinkle the mint over them and gently toss, being careful not to bruise the berries. Taste and adjust the seasonings to your palate.

**May 29<sup>th</sup> 1916** The U.S. President's flag was adopted by executive order. It was changed by President Truman in 1945. The new flag used the same basic design for the eagle, except (in response to some heraldic criticisms) changed the eagle to face towards its right (the direction of honor) and thus towards the olive branch, and the eagle was changed to be in full color. Instead of the four stars, a circular ring of 48 stars was added around the eagle. The only changes have been to add more stars for new states.

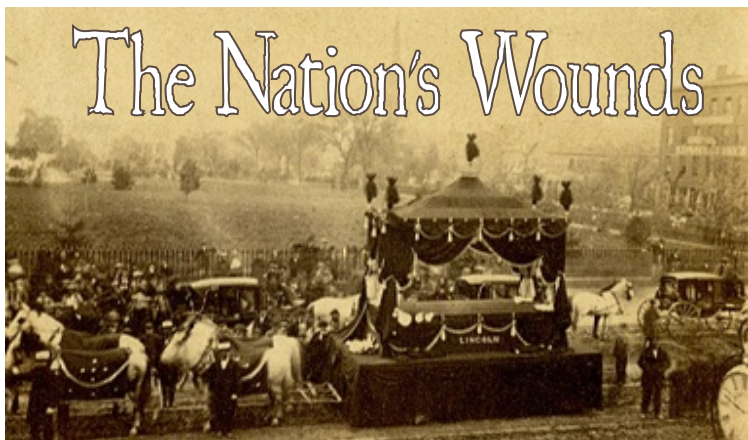

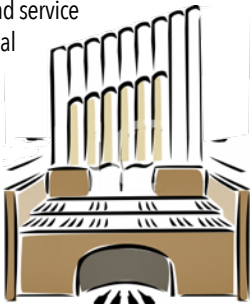

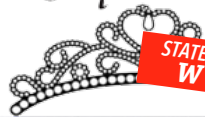
