

IRISH POTATO SALAD



Any summer entreeing has to include potato salad. The secret to a killer potato salad is to remember K.I.S.S., which stands for "Keep it Simple Silly." When we decided to look up "Traditional Irish Potato Salad" recipe online we got results including mad things like shallots, dijon mustard, cayenne pepper and so on. So failing on finding a recipe from an expert we decided to go with how our own families make theirs. [Here it goes.](#)

Preparation time: 25 minutes • Serves 5 / 6 people (as a side)

gather up

1 lb small new potatoes • 1 tbsp butter • 1/2 cup mayo
Salt and a little freshly ground black pepper
1 tbsp chopped fresh chives to garnish

fix it

- Put the potatoes on the boil for 20 to 25 minutes. Until they fall off the knife when you stab them
- Strain them and cut them into bite-sized pieces if needed. Pour into bowl
 - Add butter and stir until melted
 - Add mayo, and salt and pepper and stir until potatoes are coated
 - Garnish with chives
- Clean off the side of the bowl and add a spoon to serve


