**7** The **United Colonies** makes a name change and become The United States. 1775, **Richard Henry Lee** of Virginia proposed to the Continental Congress a resolution calling for a Declaration of Independence. 1776, The first **'dime novel'** offered for sale on this day. (said to have sold 300,000 copies in the first year) 1860, **J.F. Palmer** patented the cord bicycle tire. 1892, **"The \$64,000 Question"**, a summer replacement show, with host Hal March, premiered. 1955, **"Thank God I'm A Country Boy"** by **John Denver** topped the charts. 1975

**8** Commercially manufactured **ice cream** was advertised for the first time. 1786, **Ives W. McGaffey** received a patent for the suction vacuum cleaner. 1869, Congress authorized the **penny postal card**. 1872, **"The Milton Berle Show"** premieres on NBC Tv. 1948, **"Love Letters in the Sand"** by **Pat Boone** topped the charts in 1957

**9** **John Barry** copyrighted **Philadelphia Spelling Book**. It was the first American book to be copyrighted. 1790, **Robert H. Goddard** patented a rocket-fueled aircraft design. 1931, Disney's Donald Duck makes his debut. 1934, **Secretariat** won the first **"Triple Crown"** winner

in 25 years. 1973, **"The Purple People Eater"** by **Sheb Wooley** topped the charts in 1958

**10** Dutch colonists settle on **Manhattan Island** 1610, **Benjamin Franklin** flies a kite in a lightning storm and discovers electricity. 1752, **Naval Academy** in Annapolis, held its first graduation. 1854, The **SOS** distress signal was used for the first time. 1909, **Alcoholic Anonymous** was founded. 1935, **Pete Rose** of the Phillies singled off of Houston's Nolan Ryan to tie Stan Musial's baseball career-hit total at 3,630. A baseball strike of 50 days thwarted 'Charlie Hustle's' efforts to break the NL record. 1981

**11** The first patent for a stove was issued -- to **Robert Haeterick**. 1793, The movie **E.T. The Extra-Terrestrial** was released 1982, **William Beebe** dove to a record-setting depth of 1,426 feet, in a bathysphere. 1930, **Seattle Slew** wins Belmont Stakes & Triple Crown. 1977, **"Flashdance...What a Feeling"** by **Irene Cara** topped the charts. 1983

**12** **Abner Doubleday** created the game of baseball. 1839, The gas mask was patented by **L.P. Haslett**. 1849, **John Lee Richmond** pitches baseball's first "Perfect Game". 1880, **Harry Houdini** frees himself from a straitjacket while suspended upside down. 1923, **Sen. Huey Long** of Louisiana made the longest speech on

Senate record. The speech took 15 1/2 hours and was filled by 150,000 words. 1935, **Ben Hogan** won his first U.S. Open golf classic. 1948

# Hemingway daiquiri

His request for a Daiquiri made with half the sugar and double the booze created an unbalanced drink: one that bartenders couldn't help but right through the eventual addition of maraschino liqueur and grapefruit juice. To reinstate some of Hemingway's influence, this recipe uses **key lime** juice and goes for a whirl in the blender as the earliest Daiquiris were served over crushed ice.

## here's how

Add all ingredients to a blender and fill with ice. Cover and pulse the blender until the drink has a slushy consistency. Divide the contents of the blender between 8 wine glasses and garnish each with a lime wheel.

## ingredients

- 2 cup White rum
- .75 cup key lime juice
- .5 cup Grapefruit juice
- .5 cup Maraschino liqueur
- 2 tsp Simple syrup

**Request Significant Health Insurance Rate Increases**

**Commissioner Karen Weldin Stewart Vows Vigorous Review**  
(DOVER, DE) Commissioner Karen Weldin Stewart announced last week that she has received rate request filings from Highmark Blue Cross Blue Shield of Delaware and Aetna, Inc. for individual and small group plans to be offered on Delaware's Health Insurance Marketplace in 2016. Highmark is asking for a 25.4% increase in the individual market, while Aetna requests a 16% increase. In the small group market, Highmark seeks a 12.7% increase, while Aetna asks for a 6.1% decrease.


"Large rate increase requests like these are occurring in several states across the country and I know they will cause a hardship for many Delawareans," said Stewart. "The increases are substantial and I'm going to do my best to reduce them. I am instructing my actuaries to examine vigorously Highmark's and Aetna's supporting data for the requests."

Commissioner Stewart also announced that the Insurance Department will conduct **public information sessions** in June to receive comment on the proposed rate increases. The sessions will take place at the following locations in the three counties:

- Mon., June 15 1pm Del Tech Owens Campus, Georgetown
- Mon., June 15 6pm Insurance Department, 841 Silver Lake Blvd., Dover
- Tues., June 16 6pm Carvel State Office Building, 820 N. French St. Wilmington
