9 John Barry copyrighted *Philadelphia Spelling Book*. It was the first American book to be copyrighted. 1790, Robert H. Goddard patented a rocket-fueled aircraft design. 1931, Disney's Donald Duck makes his debut. 1934, *Secretariat* won the first Triple Crown winner in 25 years. 1973, *The Purple People Eater* by Sheb Wooley topped the charts in 1958

10 Dutch colonists settle on *Manhattan Island* 1610, Benjamin Franklin flies a kite in a lightning storm and discovers electricity. 1752, *Naval Academy* in Annapolis, held its first graduation. 1854, The SOS distress signal was used for the first time. 1909, *Alcoholic Anonymous* was founded. 1935, *Pete Rose* of the Phillies singled off of Houston's Nolan Ryan to tie Stan Musial's baseball career-hit total at 3,630. A baseball strike of 50 days thwarted 'Charlie Hustle's' efforts to break the NL record. 1981

CRAB CAKES

Always in the appetizers sections of best seafood restaurants. So a lot of people are intimidated to make them at home. DON'T BE. They're so easy, literally anyone can do it. Here's everything you need to know. You should use mayo.

It's the perfect binder, and its subtle creaminess won't compete with the crab. Mayo haters, you can use Greek yogurt instead. Hot sauce + Worcestershire + Dijon = MAJOR upgrades. The taste of crab isn't particularly strong. It needs a little oomph to wake it up. Enter this trio of bold condiments. A little bit is good.

GATHER UP

1/3 c. Mayonnaise - 1 large egg, beaten - 2 tbsp. Dijon mustard - 2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce - 1/2 tsp. hot sauce - Kosher salt & Freshly ground black pepper - 1 lb. jumbo lump crabmeat - 3/4 c. panko bread crumbs or saltines - 2 tbsp. Freshly Chopped Parsley - Canola oil, for frying - Lemon wedges, for serving - Tartar sauce, for serving

EASY STEPS

1. In a small bowl, whisk together mayo, egg, Dijon mustard, Worcestershire, and hot sauce, and season with salt and pepper.
2. In a medium bowl, stir together crabmeat, panko (or broken - not crushed saltines), and parsley. Fold in mayo mixture, then form into 8 patties.
3. In a large skillet over medium-high heat, coat pan with oil and heat until shimmering. Add crab cakes and cook, in batches, until golden and crispy, 3 to 5 minutes per side.
4. Serve with lemon and tartar sauce

If you haven't tried kumquats in place of other citrus in your cocktails, then let this drink be your on-ramp. The tiny fruits are muddled and shaken with gin, lemon juice, Luxardo maraschino liqueur and nutmeg for a sweet and sour smash you'll love.

2 oz your fav GIN - 3 Kumquats, halved
2/3 oz Fresh lemon juice - 1/3 oz Luxardo maraschino liqueur - Nutmeg

In a shaker, muddle the kumquats.
Add remaining ingredients and ice and shake.
Double-strain into an Old Fashioned glass over fresh ice.
Garnish with 2 kumquats.

FLAG DAY

In the United States, Flag Day is celebrated on June 14. It commemorates the adoption of the flag of the United States, which happened that day by resolution of the Second Continental Congress in 1777.

In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that officially established June 14 as Flag Day; in August 1949, National Flag Day was established by an Act of Congress.

Flag Day is not an official federal holiday, though on June 14, 1937, Pennsylvania became the first (and only) U.S. state to celebrate Flag Day as a state holiday, beginning in the town of Rennerdale. Title 36 of the United States Code, Subtitle I, Part A, CHAPTER 1, § 110 is the official statute on Flag Day; however, it is at the President's discretion to proclaim officially the observance.

One of the longest-running Flag Day parades is held annually in Quincy, Massachusetts. Carrying on the tradition of the Koch Club, the Quincy Flag Day parade (1.2 miles) is the longest-running parade of its kind in the nation. The 69th Annual Appleton Flag Day Parade will be held on June 8, 2019, and will be a tribute to the U.S. Marine Corps.

The largest Flag Day parade is held annually in Troy, New York, which bases its parade on the Quincy parade and typically draws 50,000 spectators.

Perhaps the oldest continuing Flag Day parade is at Fairfield WA. Beginning in 1909 or 1910, Fairfield has held a parade every year since, with the possible exception of 1918, and will celebrated the "Centennial" parade in 2010. <http://www.usflag.org/uscode36.html>

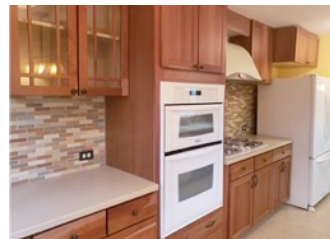

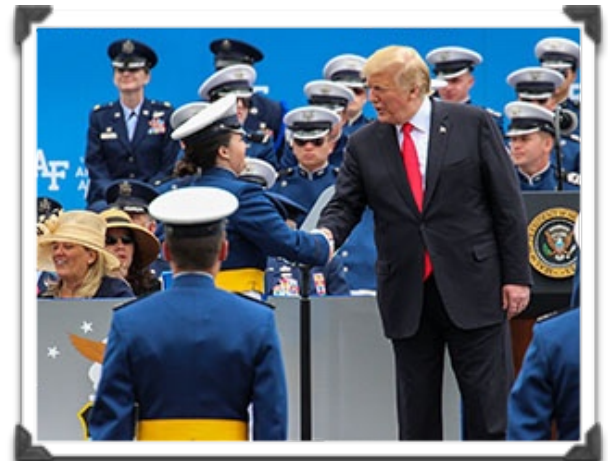

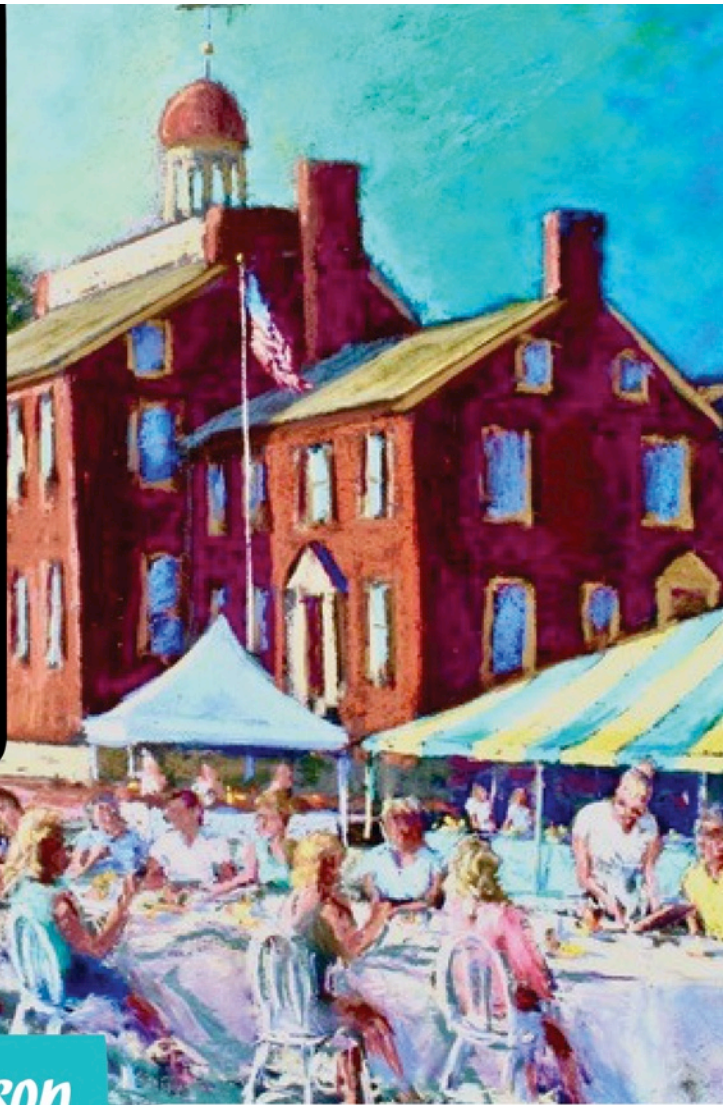
