

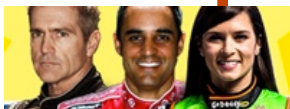

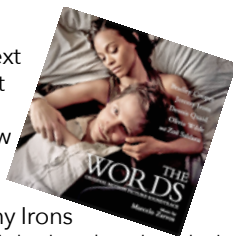

maple-bacon chocolate chip cookies

"This recipe was born out of a challenge to include bacon in a cookie batter. While that has been done before, the inclusion of chocolate chips and maple together in a whipped batter make this a sweet-yet-savory chewy cookie treat!" – Mike "Tartags"

ingredients

Recipe makes 24 cookies

- 2 c.s all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1 c. butter, room temperature
- 3/4 c. packed brown sugar
- 3/4 c. white sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 tsp maple extract
- 1/3 c. chopped cooked bacon
- 1 c. bittersweet chocolate chips

directions

1. Preheat an oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper. Whisk together the flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt; set aside.
2. Beat together the butter, brown sugar, and white sugar with an electric mixer until smooth. Add one egg; beat until blended into the butter mixture. Add the remaining egg, vanilla extract, and maple extract; beat until well blended and slightly fluffy. Stir in the flour mixture a little at a time, mixing just until combined. Stir in the bacon and chocolate chips. Scoop by rounded tablespoonfuls onto prepared cookie sheets.
3. Bake in the preheated oven until edges turn golden brown, 10 to 12 minutes. Remove from the oven, and cool on a wire rack.

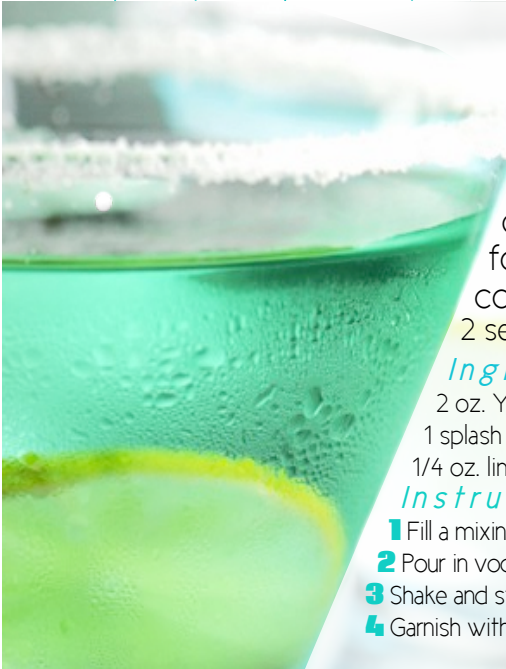
2 servings

WALKING TOURS of BATTERY PARK

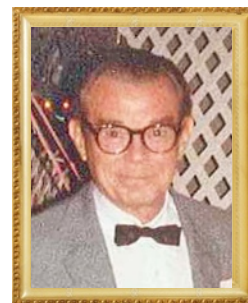


Wednesday, June 26, 6:00pm

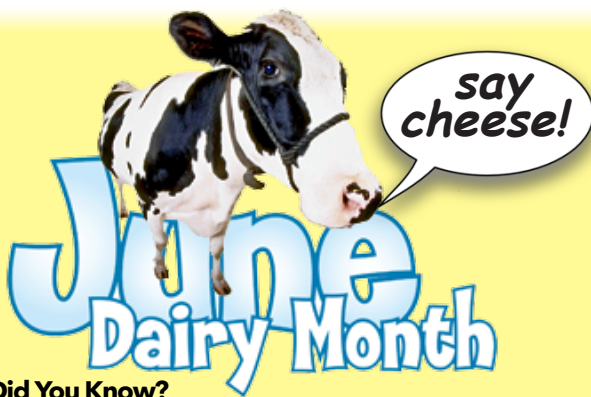

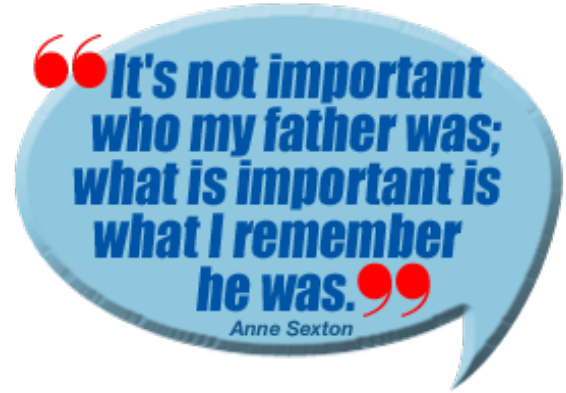


Did You Know?

- ➔ The most popular cheese recipe in the United States is "macaroni and cheese."
- ➔ There are over 2,000 varieties of cheeses.
- ➔ Cheese takes up about 1/10 the volume of the milk it was made from
- ➔ A giant wheel of Cheddar cheese was given to Queen Victoria (1837-1901) for a wedding gift. It weighed over 1,000 pounds. A normal Cheddar wheel weighs 60-75 pounds.

Serving & Storage Tips

- ➔ Unpasteurized cheese with a range of flavors should not be sliced until purchase otherwise it will start to lose its subtlety and aroma.
- ➔ Keep the cheese in conditions in which it matures. Hard, semi-hard and semi-soft cheeses are stored in the temperatures from around 8 - 13 C.
- ➔ Keep the cheese wrapped in the waxed paper and place it in a loose-fitting food-bag not to lose humidity and maintain the circulation of air. Wrap blue cheeses all over as mould spores spread readily not only to other cheeses but also to everything near.
- ➔ Chilled cheeses should be taken out of the refrigerator one and a half or two hours before serving.
- ➔ Cheeses contain living organisms that must not be cut off from air, yet it is important not to let a cheese dry out.
- ➔ Do not store cheese with other strong-smelling foods. As a cheese breathes it will absorb other aromas and may spoil.
- ➔ Wrap soft cheeses loosely. Use waxed or greaseproof paper rather than cling film.
- ➔ Let cold cheese warm up for about half an hour before eating to allow the flavor and aroma to develop.
