MSC's Water Main Cleaning and Lining Project



There has been some confusion regarding the Sewer Main relining project being performed by New Castle County with their contractor AM-Liner East, Inc. and the Municipal Services Commission (MSC) of the City of New Castle's Water Main Cleaning and Lining Project performed by MSC's contractor J. Fletcher Creamer (JFC). If you receive notifications regarding the projects please note the government agency and contractor to help avoid confusion. The MSC project began Monday, June 10, 2019 and will include Delaware Street from 4th to 6th Street and East 4th Street from Delaware to Harmony Street. MSC's contractor JFC is on-site installing temporary water mains to supply water to the residents on these streets. Once the lines are flushed and tested JFC will begin the process of transferring resident's water service to the temporary system. It is anticipated this will be completed the week of June 17th. As a reminder, if you are connected to the temporary water system, you will not be charged for the water consumed during the project.

During the weekend starting June 21, 2019, MSC will be closing the intersection of 6th and Delaware Street to replace the water main. The work will start on Friday evening lasting through the weekend with the goal of reopening the intersection Monday morning. Rebuilding of the 4th and 5th Street intersections will begin the week of June 24, 2019.

The work schedule is subject to change due to weather related events and / or unforeseen complications. No Parking will be posted on these streets at various times throughout the project. The MSC appreciates everyone's cooperation and understanding while the water system is improved. Please feel free to contact the customer service department with any questions at (302) 322-2330.

Beekeeper's Honey Cornbread

1½ c. coarse ground yellow cornmeal
3/4 c. all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon salt
2 teaspoons baking powder
2 eggs, beaten
1½ c. buttermilk
3 tbsp unsalted butter, melted
2 tbsp honey (for a sweeter cornbread, use 4 tbsp honey)
Preheat oven to 375 degrees Fahrenheit. Grease a 12 x 8 in.



baking pan with butter.

In a large mixing bowl, stir together the cornmeal, flour, salt, and baking powder.

In a separate bowl, mix the eggs and buttermilk together. Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients and stir until just combined (the mixture will remain slightly lumpy). Stir in the butter and honey.

Pour the batter into the prepared baking pan and bake for about 25-30 minutes, until golden brown on top and a toothpick, inserted in the center, comes out clean.

Allow the cornbread to cool slightly before serving. Well wrapped, this cornbread keeps for 1-2 days.

grand mojito martini

gonna need

1 lime cut into 8 pieces
1/2 orange cut into 4 pieces
16 mint leaves, plus 1 for garnish
1 oz. Ten Can Rum
1 oz. Grand Marnier

1/2 oz. simple syrup • Two dashes bitters

make some

First chill a 10-ounce martini glass. Then, in a 16-ounce pint glass, build the lime and orange with 16 mint leaves. Muddle until mint is aromatic and citrus are juicy. Shake vigorously with fresh ice until shaker is frosted. Add rum, Grand Marnier and simple syrup and then strain into chilled martini glass. Finish with bitters. Float mint leaf on top.



ultimate margarita

gonna need

1 lime, halved
Coarse salt
1/2 c. freshly squeezed lime juice, from about 4 limes
1 tablespoon sugar
1/4 c. orange-flavored liqueur

1/4 c. Triple Sec • 1 c. gold tequila • Ice • 1/2 can good quality lager-style beer • Lime wheels, for garnish

make some

To salt the margarita glasses, rub the outside rims of 4 big glasses with a cut lime and press them lightly into a plate of kosher salt, to coat.

Combine the lime juice, sugar, orange liqueur, Triple Sec, tequila, and a big handful of ice in a cocktail shaker (or blender). Shake the margarita really well, for a good 20 seconds, add a splash of beer and strain into the salt rimmed glasses filled with ice. Garnish with a lime wheel



orange cream mimosa

gonna need

2 1/2 c.s freshly squeezed orange juice (5 to 6 oranges)
1 orange, zested 1 c. half-and-half
1 c. superfine sugar
1 bottle sparkling wine or Champagne
Strawberries, for garnish

make some

Put orange juice, zest, half-and-half, and sugar into a blender and process until the sugar has dissolved, about 30 seconds. Pour this mixture into a shallow pan and freeze until hard, 4 hours or overnight. Remove the frozen orange mixture from the freezer and let it sit to soften slightly, about 10 minutes. With a scoop or tablespoon, scrape out a small scoop and put it into a Champagne glass. Slowly fill the glass with Champagne and serve garnished with strawberries.

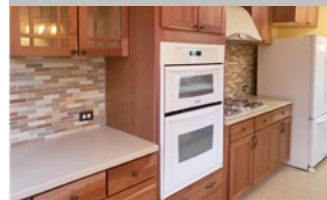

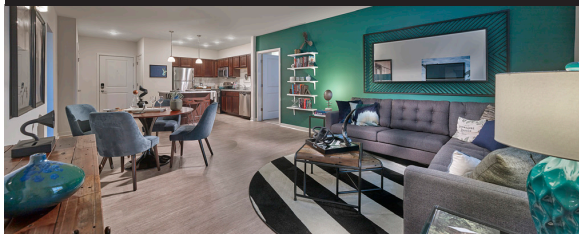

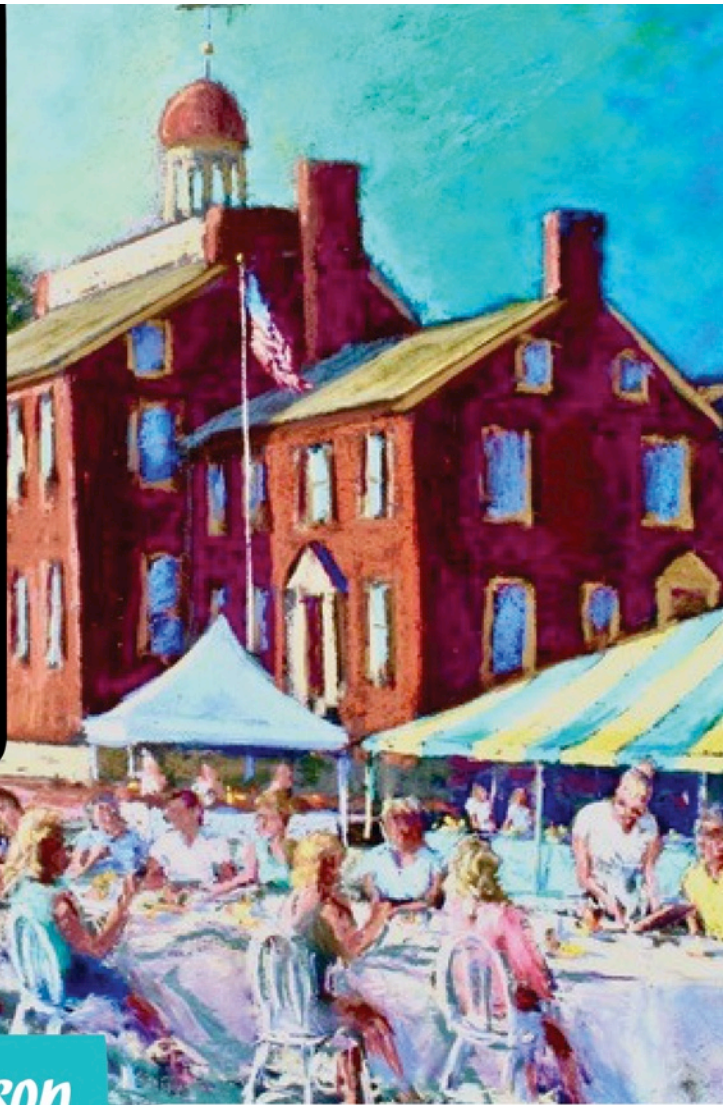
