NCCP will dedicate the first of a series of "wayside exhibits" on Fri., June 24th at 1pm at 2nd and Chestnut Streets. NCCP president Laura Fontana has invited all

interested citizens to attend. This exhibit, on the site of Fort Casimir, tells the story of the first settlement in New Castle and the conflict among the Netherlands, Sweden, and Great Britain for supremacy on the Delaware. It includes thoroughly-researched art by Len Tantillo that helps visitors imagine what the original fort looked like. Nine other exhibits are planned. . Delaware Secretary of State Jeffrey Bullock will be the principal speaker. Secretary Bullock oversees the Division of Historical and Cultural Affairs which conducted archeological investigations at the Fort Casimir site.

"This Swedish dish takes its name from Hasselbacken, the Stockholm restaurant where it was first served. The seasoned potatoes turn out crisp on the outside and tender on the iwaidedie video

gonna need

16 oz red new potatoes 3 to 5 garlic cloves, thinly sliced 4 tbsps unsalted butter, melted 2 tbsps olive oil Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

berbed sour cream

 $1/2~{\rm cup}~{\rm sour}~{\rm cream}$ – $1/2~{\rm tsp}~{\rm garlic}~{\rm powder}$ – $1~{\rm tbsp}~{\rm finely}~{\rm chopped}~{\rm fresh}~{\rm parsley}$ – Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

here ya go.... Preheat oven to 400° F.

Using a wooden spoon as a cradle, place each potato in the spoon and make several parallel slits into each potato top making sure not to slice completely through. Place 3 garlic slices between slits at the crown of each potato. Toss in a medium bowl with butter and olive oil. Place on a baking sheet and sprinkle generously with salt and pepper. Bake until tops are crispy and potatoes are cooked through, about 1 hour. Transfer to a platter and top with Herbed Sour Cream.

Combine ingredients in a small bowl. Season, to taste, and refrigerate until use.
