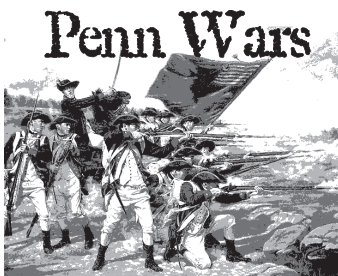
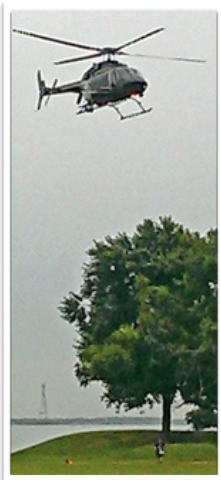

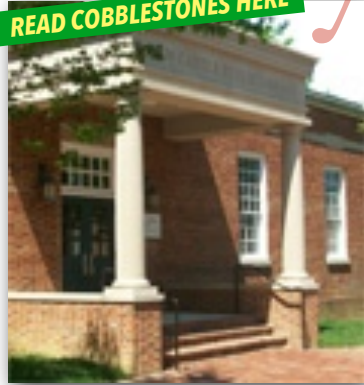

Having a **PIMM'S CUP** with strawberries and cream is the equivalent to having a hot dog and beer at a baseball game in the US.

## DENISA'S PIMM'S CUP

Make sure to start preparing the fruit a few hours ahead of when you want to serve it.

1 bottle Pimm's No. 1 Cup Liqueur

**FRUIT** (some Brits use these, but choose whatever fruits you like)

2 nectarines, cut into nibble size pieces

1 apple, cut into nibble size pieces

small bunch of grapes, cut into halves if they are large

1 banana, cut up

strawberries, cut up

2 bottles of white wine

2 12 oz cans Sprite (with sugar)

Place all the cut up fruit in a large bowl or punch bowl, then pour the bottle of Pimm's over the fruit, cover and set aside for 2-3 hours. Serves 8-10



**Cool and creamy** frozen peanut butter pie with chocolate crust!  
This **EASY** no-bake treat is the perfect way to beat the summer heat!

### Ingredients

- ▶ 1 chocolate pie crust (supermarket)
- ▶ 1 1/4 cups half and half or milk ▶ 1/4 cup sugar ▶ 1/2 teaspoon vanilla - 3/4 cup creamy peanut butter ▶ 4 oz cream cheese softened ▶ 1 8-ounce container frozen cool whip, thawed
- ▶ optional: 1/2 cup peanuts roughly chopped, chocolate shavings

### Instructions

- ▶ In a large bowl beat half and half (or milk) with the sugar 1 to 2 minutes. Add vanilla and peanut butter and mix until smooth. Chill 30 minutes.
- ▶ Whip cream cheese until fluffy. Add cream cheese to chilled peanut butter mixture from Step 1. Add whipped cream and mix until smooth. (Optional: add 1/4 cup roughly chopped peanuts.) Pour mixture into pie crust. Freeze uncovered 4 hours or overnight. Top frozen pie with remaining chopped peanuts and chocolate shavings if desired. Transfer to fridge to thaw about 30 minutes before serving.

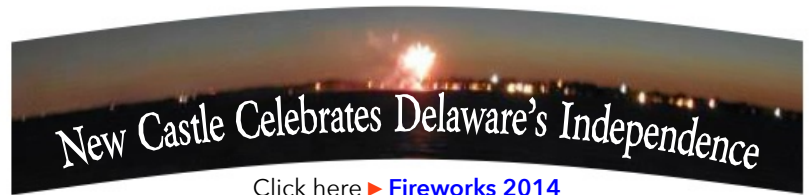
