Buildings include, from left to right, the newly built **Academy** (1802), a rather small **Immanuel Church** (the church was enarged and the steeple added in the 1820 renovation. Some ships north of Harmony street, the **house** at the corner of Harmony and 2nd with its adjacent blacksmith shop, what appears to be the 4 houses of **Aull's row** (though they appear to have extension over the street) and the **Courthouse** and its outbuildings. 


