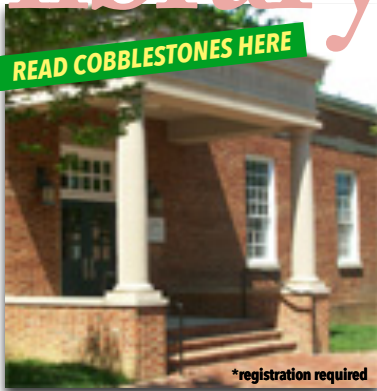

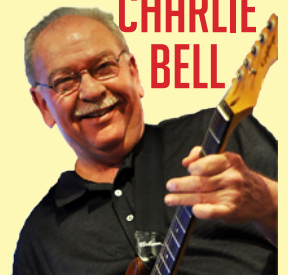

# tomatoes with garlicky white sauce & oregano

A sauce that tastes like a cross between ranch and Alabama white sauce, which means you can basically put it on anything.

## gonna need

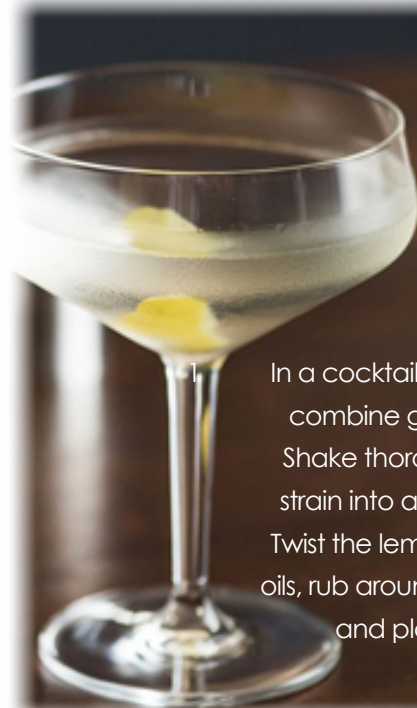
- 1 cup mayo • ½ cup evaporated milk • 1 garlic clove, finely grated • Kosher salt, and freshly ground pepper
- 3 pounds mixed heirloom tomatoes, cut into 1½-inch pieces • 1 tablespoon oregano leaves

## now...

Whisk mayo, evaporated milk, garlic, a big pinch of salt, and a few grinds of pepper in a medium bowl. *(It should be the consistency of pancake batter.)*

Toss tomatoes with a big pinch of salt in a large bowl, then transfer to a platter. Drizzle sauce over to your liking (you don't need to use all of it) and top with oregano. Grind more pepper over.

**do ahead** White sauce can be made 1 day ahead. Cover and chill.



# Vesper

- 3 ounces gin
- 1 ounce vodka
- 1/2 ounce Kina Lillet
- 1 lemon peel

In a cocktail shaker filled with ice, combine gin, vodka, and lillet. Shake thoroughly, and double-strain into a chilled martini glass. Twist the lemon peel to release its oils, rub around the rim of the glass, and place in the drink.

## New Castle's Paulownia Tree



A New Castle favorite is the Paulownia Tree with large purple blooms. The tree tells a tale of 1700's ships full of Chinese export porcelain being unloaded in New Castle and the dried pods from the Paulownia used as packing material being discarded, only to later sprout and grow into these big, beautiful trees. (see *The Big Green Umbrella at the NC Historical Society*). The wood is highly prized in China for dowry chests, and I remember many years ago hearing that the Chinese were trying to buy trees in Delaware to import back to China, because they could not get enough of the wood for their daughters' dowries!

Nick McIntire muses in the April 3, 1959 Behind the Times, "Of course, the Paulownia is one of our most interesting and beautiful trees, especially in the spring when it puts out its foxglove-like purple flowers which have a delicate fragrance. We know there are those who contend the paulownia is a "dirty" tree, and while not disputing such assertion would counter with what trees are not"?



# Delaware museums accredited

The five museums operated by the Delaware Division of Historical and Cultural Affairs have been accredited by the American Alliance of Museums (AAM), the highest recognition afforded to museums in the United States.



"Achieving accreditation is the gold standard of the museum profession" said Timothy Slavin, director of the Division of Historical and Cultural Affairs. "This achievement is doubly significant because we persevered and achieved it during trying economic times for the State of Delaware. Across our entire division, we maintained focus and effectiveness and our role as cultural stewards was recognized."

Accreditation signifies excellence to the museum community, to governments, funders, outside agencies and the museum-going public. The newly accredited state museums include the **John Dickinson Plantation** near Kitts Hummock; the **Johnson Victrola Museum** and **Old State House** in downtown Dover; the **New Castle Court House Museum**; and the **Zwaanendael Museum** in Lewes. State museums are under the stewardship of the Department of State.

"Our state museums, and the collections they house, are treasures to be appreciated by Delawareans and visitors alike, and the dedicated team at the Division of Historical and Cultural Affairs serve as excellent caretakers," said Secretary of State Jeffrey Bullock. "The people of Delaware can be proud of the work they do and the rich historic and cultural legacy they help preserve and safeguard for all of us."

Of the nation's estimated 33,000 museums, approximately 1,000 currently are accredited. Delaware's state museums join only two other museums accredited in Delaware.
