Last week an inquiring Cobble asked about the latest buzz that's been heard on the street for a clarification. Parking! Surprised?

Landing in the Cobble in-box was this item...

"The latest is the talk of making West 3rd Street **no parking at all** and limit it to 30 minutes only to unload etc. then residents would have designated spaces marked as such is newly created lots yet to be determined but most likely right off the bank parking lot".

Cobblestones reached out. "While there are plans for more new parking behind the Bank, on Trustees property, design and engineering have not begun yet" I was told.

As for making West 3rd Street No Parking with limited residential access there is no factual basis for this rumor. The City has **no plans** to make any changes to parking on W. Third Street. Changing from 1 hour daily parking to 2 hour parking from 5th Street to 4th Street, on South Side of Delaware Street from 8am.to 6 pm Monday – Saturday may have promoted this rumor.
