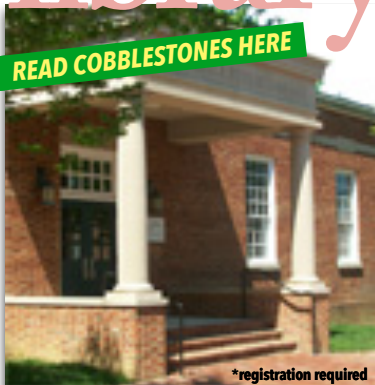

4 chicken legs • Kosher salt, freshly ground pepper • 2 tbsp olive oil • 2 small onions, thinly sliced • 2 pounds mixed tomatoes, cut into wedges if large • 3 3-inch cinnamon sticks • 1 tbsp fresh lemon juice • Lemon wedges (for serving)

Season chicken generously with salt and pepper. Heat oil in a medium Dutch oven or heavy shallow pot over medium-high. Cook chicken, skin side down, reducing heat as needed to avoid scorching, until skin is deep golden brown, 10–12 minutes. Transfer to a plate.

Reduce heat to medium and add onions to same pot. Cook, stirring occasionally, until very soft and just beginning to brown around the edges, 8–10 minutes. Add tomatoes and cinnamon sticks. Cook, stirring occasionally, until tomatoes are softened and juices have thickened slightly, 6–8 minutes. Return chicken to pot, arranging skin side up. Cover pot, reduce heat to low, and simmer gently until chicken is cooked through, 45–60 minutes.

Uncover pot and continue to simmer until juices are thickened and meat is close to falling off the bone, 45–60 minutes. Add lemon juice; taste and season with more salt and pepper as needed. Serve with lemon wedges.

Do Ahead: Chicken can be braised 3 days ahead. Let cool in liquid; cover and chill. Reheat gently before serving.

Parking Lot Ordinance 510 passed

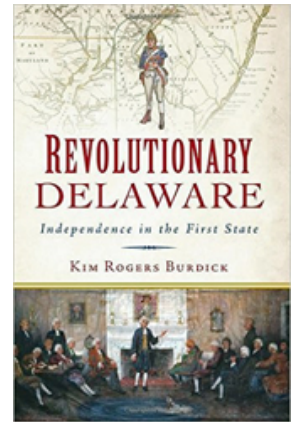
The much contested issue of an Ordinance to make parking lot usage of properties in any residentially zoned district, the Historic Residence District and the Historic Commerce District permissible only with the grant, of a special exception, from the Board of Adjustment. City Solicitor Losco explained the three tiered process; Panning Commission, Historic Area Commission and Board of Adjustment, and that all three could deny a request. Councilman John DiMondi offered an amendment to make Council have the final decision and not the Board Of Adjustment. Saying that they are appointed, and we are elected and should be accountable to the Citizens. His motion failed. Council continued their discussion making and passing a minor word change. The the vote...4-1 (DiMondi). With that the meeting closed and the anger erupted, inside and on to the street.

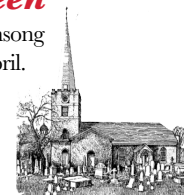
