Council President Ratchford said that was an inappropriate question and wouldn't allow it.

So the big day - Monday, August 21st is nearly here. Are you all ready for the total eclipse of the sun?

Eye Safety During a Total Solar Eclipse

It is never safe to look directly at the sun's rays even if the sun is partly obscured. When watching a

partial eclipse you must wear eclipse glasses at all times if you want to face the sun, or use an alternate indirect method. This also applies during a total eclipse up until the time when the sun is completely and totally blocked.

During the short time when the moon completely obscures the sun – known as the period of totality – it is safe to look directly at the star, but it's crucial that you know when to take off and put back on your glasses. *We will see 80% of totality.*

First and foremost: Check for local information on timing of when the total eclipse will begin and end. <u>NASA's page of eclipse times</u> is a good place to start.

WACKY WEDNESDAYS

baked Darmesan

This recipe isn't only easy and fast, it also is filling, delicious, and the perfect healthy, appetizer or side dish. There are only a few calories per halved tomato!

4 large tomatoes (use heirlooms if they're in season!) • 1/3 cup parmesan cheese block, freshly grated • 1/4 cup powdered parmesan • 3 tbsp fresh basil, finely chopped • 1 tsp salt • 1/4 tsp pepper • 4 garlic cloves minced into a paste • 1/2 tsp crushed chili pepper • 1.5 tbsp olive oil

Make oven happy at 400°. Prepare your tomatoes: Wash and cut them in half and place on a baking dish lined with parchment paper cut side up. Season tomato with salt and pepper. Mix cheeses, basil, garlic, crushed chili pepper and olive oil. Then, evenly spread mixture on top of each tomato. For added crunch add some breadcrumbs.

Bake in the oven for 15 minutes until juices just start to bubble but tomato still holds its shape.



Slap a mint sprig between your hands and use as garnish. Serve with a straw.
