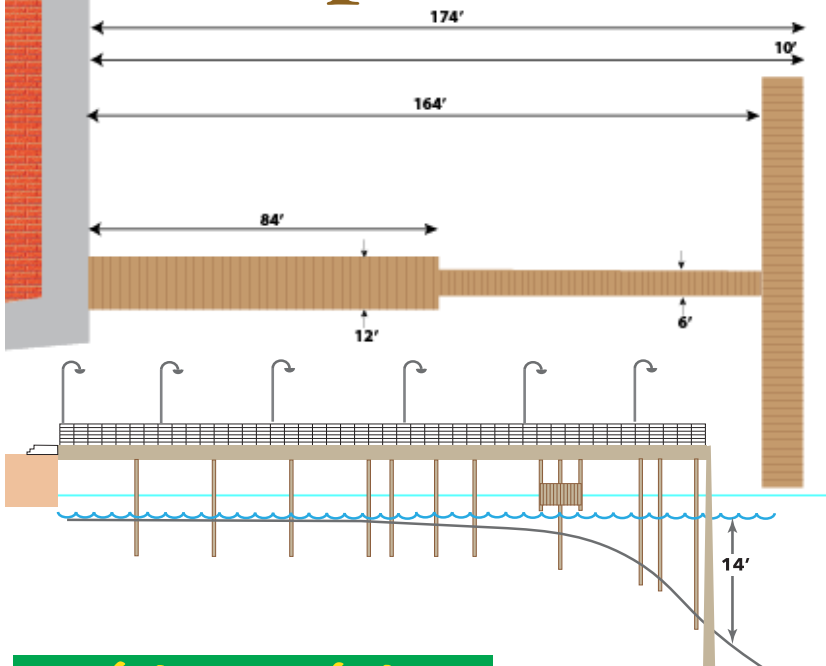

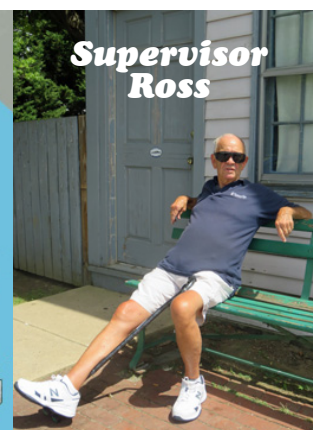
CITY COUNCIL tidings



A standing room only crowd gathered for the regular City Council meeting last Tuesday.

The Pokémon craze caused most of the evening's outrage. Battery Park's closing time of 9pm being ignored was a main point. Chris Castagno, Trustees Battery Park Committee Chair, extended the closing time to 11pm in agreement with Chief Rogers. Many questioned Castagno's authority. "You're the government in this City not him", one resident told Council.

City officials want you to know



The City continues to work diligently to manage our resources and provide a positive experience for both visitors and residents. Due to recent increased visitation, we are adding some additional measures to address safety, parking, traffic and trash concerns through the following actions:

- **Battery Park Hours Enforcement:** Based on recommendation from the Police, and in cooperation with the Battery Park Committee, the City experimented with temporarily relaxing late night enforcement as a way to reduce sidewalk/street pedestrian traffic. Taking citizen feedback into consideration, City police will resume previous practices, and will continue to monitor.
- **Seasonal Police Officer** coverage will be extended into the fall and increased traffic and parking enforcement actions including ticketing will continue.
- **Parking meters and resident sticker** options are being evaluated.
- **More trashcans** and cigarette butt holders with more frequent pickup are being added to Delaware Street and along the Green.

We ask citizens to immediately call **911** in case of any emergency or any time an immediate response is needed.

We are identifying and filling potholes in addition to other road and drainage projects. Please call City Office at **322-9801** if you would like to report any issues in your neighborhood.

We are proud of the safety, cleanliness and beauty of our City and the personal service we provide our citizens and are continually working to better serve our community.

In other news...on Tues., Aug. 2nd the Cabinet Committee on State Planning Issues met to review Downtown Development District (DDD) applications. The City of New Castle was one of nine applications. Despite a competitive application and strong District Plan, the City's application was not one of the five selected for DDD designation. As relayed by staff of the review committee, New Castle had a strong plan and application but the selected communities—Smyrna, Milford, Harrington, Laurel, and Georgetown—had a greater need for the designation in terms of income, homeownership rates, abandoned or vacant buildings, etc. The City thanks the DDD Task Force who dedicated their time and knowledge to help prepare the application and the District Plan. The City also appreciates the tremendous support from the downtown establishments who promoted the survey and opened their doors for the event.

Chief Rogers urged all residents to call 911 if they encounter a problem. 44 arrests have been made, including one resident harassing the PokéPeople. 11 speeding tickets were issued in one location. The Chief warned that if you get stopped, the "but I live here" excuse won't work. A Delaware Street resident berated Council for worrying about visitors while ignoring the needs of the residents; citing the sidewalk's and curb's lack of attention over the years. He said the influx of game players are defacing his house and leaving trash all over the place.

Now, if the City could enact a tax (\$10) on each tracked Pokémon we could build two piers and rebuild Delaware Street!

An agenda item on a proposed public restroom on the site of Bicentennial Park, opposite the Town Hall on Second Street, although removed, didn't stop the comments. Bad idea.

Rivertowns Ride organizers want the restoration of the Banks Building on the wharf to be their beneficiary this year. The question, brought up by Councilman DiMondi, was why accept funds when a restoration estimate remains a mystery. Council allocated \$15,000 in the June budget to hire an expert to determine the cost of restoring the building. To date no inspection has been done.

Capo Pizza was granted permission to sell Italian water ice and snacks (no pizza) by the Sailing Club. Parking issues by Good Will Fire Co. and on Cherry Street were also discussed.

ripe tomato tart

ingredients

- 1 9-inch pie crust
- 1 1/2 cup shredded mozzarella cheese, divided
- 4 of your best tomatoes, cut into wedges
- 3/4 cup fresh basil, chopped
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1/2 cup mayo
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/8 tsp white pepper

preparation

Line an ungreased 9" tart pan with pie crust; press crust into fluted sides of pan and trim edges.

Bake at 450° for 5 to 7 minutes; remove from oven.

Sprinkle with 1/2 cup mozzarella cheese; let cool on a wire rack. Combine remaining ingredients; mix well and fill crust.

Reduce heat to 375 degrees; bake for about 20 minutes, or until bubbly on top
