## H<sup>2</sup>O woes

The big newspaper out on 141 had a blaring headline that screamed danger and dollar signs about our city's drinking water last Tuesday. MSC's Pam Patone spoke recently at City Council stating they are aware of the contamination and, while, albeit temporary, filtration is in place and a permanent, costly solution is in the works.

After reading the article, I reached out to MSC asking if the above was correct. "Yes, your assessment is correct. The cost is high but manageable and we do hope to be able to pass along the cost to the responsible parties."

The NJ reported Patone as saying... "We do have a [financial] reserve and we're fortunate that we have that in place. It's certainly not something that we wanted to have happen. And we're hoping that the investigation comes up with some kind of answers about the source and liability for the pollution."

Asking what I could report to Cobblestone readers, she added, "I would like to assure our customers that the water they are drinking is safe to drink and is in compliance with the Department of Public Health's Office of Drinking Water."

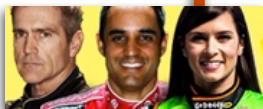

## FRENCH ONION SOUP

(almost like Julia's)

adapted from Mastering the Art of French Cooking by Julia Child

### Ingredients

1½ lbs or about 5 cups of  
thinly sliced yellow onions  
(not sweet)  
3 tbsp butter  
1 tbsp olive oil  
1 tsp Kosher salt  
¼ tsp sugar  
3 tbsp flour  
2 qts beef stock  
(or water with beef bouillon)

1/2 cup (4 oz) dry white wine  
or dry vermouth  
Kosher salt and pepper to  
taste  
1 tbsp cognac or brandy  
optional, Julia's recipe has 3 tbsps  
French, Italian or rustic loaf  
bread, cut into bite sized  
croutons, toasted  
1 to 2 cups of grated, real  
Swiss Cheese  
Julia used Swiss or Parmesan

serves 6-8

### Roll up your sleeves

In a large, heavy bottomed pot, put the butter and oil and add the sliced onions.

Cook slowly, with the lid on, for about 15 minutes.

Remove the lid, turn the heat up to medium, add the salt and sugar, and stir often for about 40 minutes (mine took 45), until the onions are a deep golden brown.

Add the flour and continue to cook and stir for another 3 or 4 minutes. Remove from heat and add the stock/water/bouillon and wine/vermouth.

Add salt and pepper to taste and return to the cooktop, and simmer for an additional 30 to 40 minutes. Just before the soup is ready, preheat the oven to 350°.

When the soup is ready, add the brandy/cognac, if using and check for seasoning; ladle it into ovenproof bowls, and top with the cubes of toasted bread.

**Now, don't go and ruin the soup by using cheap cheese!**

Use the best, *real* Gruyere from Switzerland, please.

Sprinkle the cheese on top of the toast, as desired.

Repeat to make about 6 bowls, then place them on a tray and put into the center of the oven for about 15 minutes.

Reset the oven to broil (grill) and move the tray of bowls closer to the top to get a nice golden color on the cheese, which should be watched carefully as it can burn quickly.

Serve immediately.

*It seems like kickoff is getting ever earlier, and there's nothing better for pre-noon imbibing than a Bloody Mary. This recipe, is seriously gourmet, with a homemade tomato-and-chile mix and a raw oyster on top.*

12 mild green olives, pitted  
3 (12-oz) bottles Beer

► **Roman Mix\***

12 oysters, shucked, liquor reserved  
Garnish: Olives, serrano chiles and chile threads.

**the how to** Place 2 olives in each of 6 pint glasses. Pour half a bottle of beer into each glass and top with the Roman Mix, divided evenly among the glasses. Place 2 shucked oysters with their

liquor in each glass and garnish with an additional olive, a serrano chile and a few chile threads.

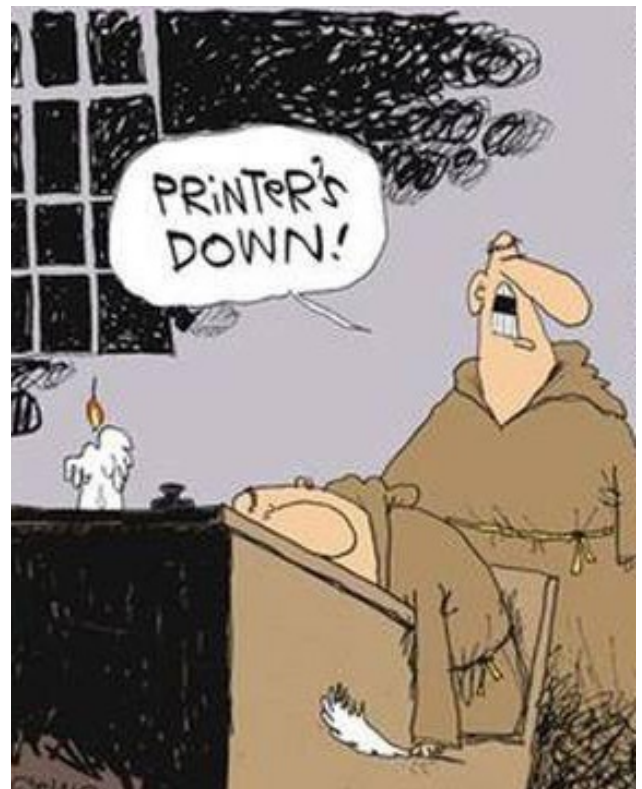
