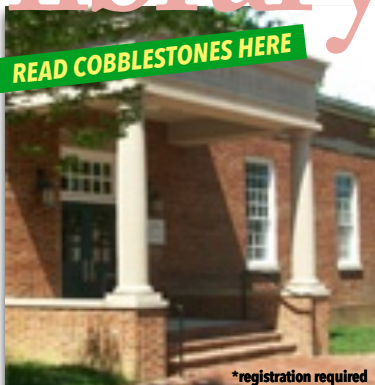

# SLOW COOKER Balsamic Honey-Glazed Chicken & Veggies

## ON THE COUNTER

4 med. carrots, cut in half lengthwise, then diagonally into 1-inch pieces ■ 3 medium Yukon gold potatoes, each cut into 6 pieces ■ 1 medium red onion, cut into thin wedges ■ 1 tsp salt ■ 1/2 tsp pepper ■ 4 bone-in skin-on chicken thighs ■ 2 tps olive oil ■ 3 tbsps balsamic vinegar ■ 2 tbsps honey ■ 3 fresh thyme sprigs



## EASY STEPS ARE...

- Spray 5-quart slow cooker with cooking spray. Place carrots, potatoes and onion in slow cooker. Season with 1/2 tsp of the salt and 1/4 tsp of the pepper.
- Season chicken thighs with remaining 1/2 teaspoon salt and 1/4 tsp pepper. In 10-inch skillet, heat oil over medium-high heat. Place chicken skin side down in skillet. Cook chicken 3 to 5 minutes, turning once, until browned on both sides. Transfer chicken to slow cooker.
- In small bowl, beat balsamic vinegar and honey with whisk. Pour over chicken in slow cooker. Place thyme sprigs around chicken. Cover; cook on High heat setting 3 1/2 to 4 hours or until juice of chicken is clear when thickest part is cut to bone (at least 165°F) and vegetables are tender.
- Remove thyme sprigs, and transfer chicken and vegetables to serving platter; cover and keep warm. Pour cooking liquid into 1-quart saucepan. Cook over medium-high heat 10 to 13 minutes or until the liquid is slightly thickened and reduced to about half. Drizzle over chicken and vegetables, and serve.

## ROAD CLOSURE

### Delaware Street @ Ferry Cut-Off

Look for **orange Detour signs** to start sprouting like spring dandelions as **Norfolk Southern Railroad Company** forces will be replacing, resurfacing and performing general maintenance at the crossing on **Delaware Street (SR 273) @ Ferry Cutoff**, New Castle, New Castle County. Estimated to begin at 5am on Mon., Sept. 18th, but could be



delayed due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

The work will require the full closure of **Delaware St (SR 273) @ Ferry Cutoff**. Message Boards will be posted 7 days in advance, advising motorists of the closure. The closure will be in place 24 hours per day. The work is expected to be completed and the detour lifted no later than 5am on Wed., Sept. 27th.

#### Detour Routes:

**Eastbound:** Delaware Street to East Basin Road onto US 13 to Boulden Boulevard to Moores Lane to Wilmington Road to Sixth Street and return to Delaware Street.

**Westbound:** Delaware Street onto Sixth Street to Wilmington Road to Moores Lane to Boulden Boulevard to US 13 to Basin Road and back to Delaware Street. Detour signage will be posted for motorists.

While **'working on the railroad...all the day long'** construction is scheduled to begin tomorrow, Sept 11th, on the 141/ US13 overpass bridge with full closure of SR141 over the bridge to last 45 days and be reopened by the beginning of November. The total contact length is 135 days, with intermittent daytime or nighttime lane closures and weekend closures of each ramp to occur after the bridge opens. ► [DelDOT Travel Restrictions](#)

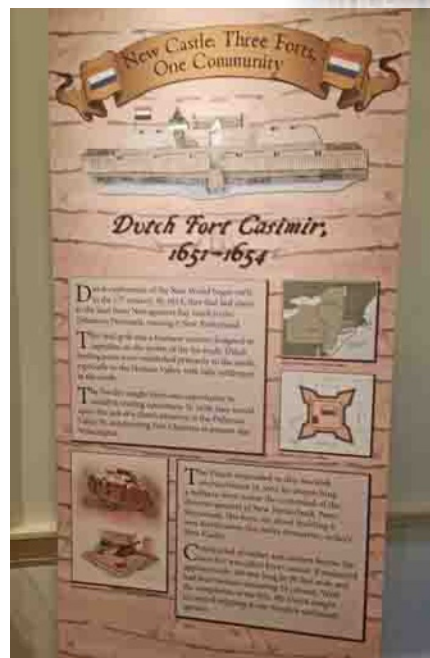

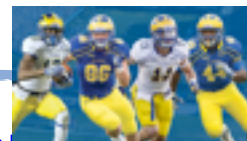
