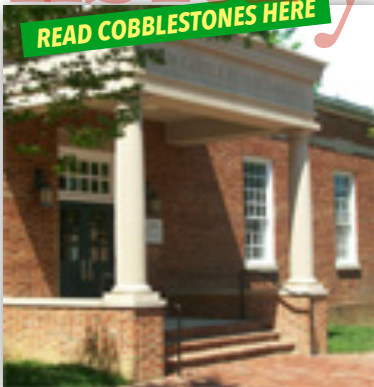

# SLOPPY JOE CUPS

A Sloppy Joes recipe starts with refrigerated biscuits pressed in muffin cups and filled with Manwich meat mixture, then sprinkled with cheese after baking



## Ingredients

- 1 pound ground chuck beef (80% lean)
- 1/2 cup chopped yellow onion
- 1 can (15 oz each) Manwich® Original Sloppy Joe Sauce

a Lakota Sioux word for "curling water" is one of those classic cocktails What sets this cocktail over the other is that the vermouth and orange juice ratios are switched. The Minnehaha concentrates on the vermouth and backs off the juice, which makes this cocktail drier.

## ingredients

- 3 Parts Gin
- 1 Part Dry Vermouth
- 1 Part Orange Juice
- 1 Part Vermouth, Sweet
- 1 Dash Pastis
- 1 Quarter Orange

Fill a shaker with ice cubes. Add all ingredients. Shake and strain into a chilled cocktail glass. Garnish with orange.
