½ cup BBQ sauce with about 45 calories per 2 tbsp. serving
1 cup shredded fat-free cheddar cheese
2 tbs. chopped scallions
Optional topping: fat-free sour cream
Preheat oven to 350°. Spread out tortilla chips on a large oven-proof platter or baking sheet sprayed with non-stick spray. Set aside. In a small bowl, combine chicken and ¼ cup barbecue sauce. Mix well and then spoon mixture evenly over chips. Top evenly with cheese. Drizzle remaining ¼ cup barbecue sauce over the chips.

Bake in the oven for 8 to 10 minutes, until cheese and barbecue sauce are hot. Sprinkle scallions over nachos. If you like, top or serve with sour cream. (Servings: 5, about 14 loaded nachos per serving)

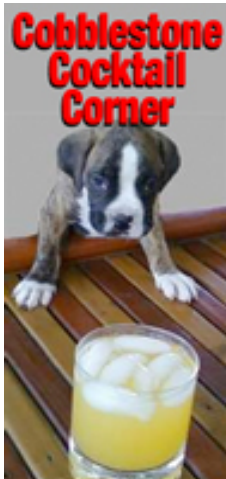

BAKON BLOODY MARY

Make a pitcher of these drinks, a riff on the Bloody Mary, the night before serving and you're ready for brunch sipping. The recipe, adapted from Jayne Rockmill's "I Love Bacon!" (Andrews McNeel Publishing, 2010), can be easily doubled. Thanks to <http://www.delawareonline.com/secondhelpings>



4 strips bacon
4 ozs. BAKON VODKA (if you can't find this smoky bacon-flavored potato vodka, use your favorite vodka)
4 cups tomato juice
4 dashes celery salt
4 dashes ground black pepper
4 dashes Tabasco sauce
8 to 16 dashes Worcestershire sauce
1/2 tsp. grated horseradish
4 tsps. freshly squeezed lime juice, plus 4 lime wedges for wetting the rim of the glass
4 cups ice cubes
4 celery stalks, for garnish
Pickled vegetable (optional)

Cook the bacon in a skillet over low heat until crispy, about 10 minutes. Drain on a paper towel. When cool, crumble the bacon into very small pieces and set aside. Combine the vodka, tomato juice, celery salt, black pepper, Tabasco, Worcestershire, horseradish, and lime juice in a pitcher. Stir until thoroughly combined. (At this point, you can refrigerate it overnight.) To serve, wet the rim of 4 highball glasses with a lime wedge, then dip the top of each glass in the crumbled bacon. Add ice and then carefully pour the liquid into the glasses. Garnish with celery stalks or pickled vegetables. Makes 4 cocktails.

LOW-FAT SPICY BBQ CHICKEN NACHOS

4 oz. (about 70) baked tortilla chips, like the kind by Guiltless Gourmet
1 9.75-oz. (or 10 oz.) can 98% fat-free chunk white chicken breast in water, drained and flaked
