It was in that capacity that she lead the committee, word by word and line by line, insuring that the New Castle that she so loved (that loved her as well) would be guided in the right direction for generations to follow. Genevieve served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War. Her love was education and even after retiring after 36 years, everyday was a learning and sharing experience she loved. In her later years her love was the companionship of Jack Gott; another New Castle legend and friend of these cobbled paths we call home.

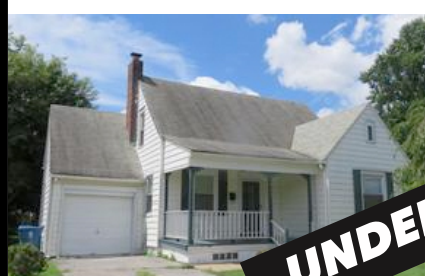
