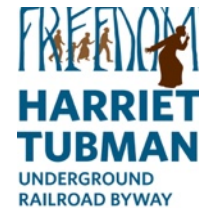

Dan worked at Fort Delaware State Park as a seasonal Historical Interpreter during the summers while attending Penn State. After graduation, he worked briefly at Colonial Williamsburg before returning to Delaware as the full time Lead Interpreter for Fort Delaware and Fort DuPont State Parks and the Port Penn Interpretive Center. He progressed to be the Historic Site Manager for those locations before transferring to Auburn Heights Preserve in 2008 to lead the effort to turn this new donation into a new state park site.

During his time with Delaware State Parks, Dan gained experience in building management, grant writing, budgeting, education and interpretation, event planning, historic preservation, and much more. Dan's wife, Heather Hansen, is the Collections Manager at the Chester County Historical Society in West Chester, PA. They have a daughter, Leah, who enjoys going for walks in Battery Park.



## The Delaware Byways Program

is a collaborative effort of Delaware's citizens, local, state and federal government. During the 2000 legislative session, the General Assembly passed Senate Bill 320 authorizing DelDOT to develop what was then known as the Delaware Scenic and Historic Highways Program. Senate Bill 320 required that the program be developed under the guidance of an Advisory Board and it required that the Board be comprised of a wide range of interests. Members of the Board include representatives of local and county government, other state agencies, metropolitan planning organizations, various environmental and historic preservation advocacy groups, and other interested individuals. The program has since been rebranded is now known as the Delaware Byways Program.

# Cream of Fresh Tomato Soup



## Ingredients

3 tbsps good olive oil - 1  
 ½ cups chopped red  
 onions (2 onions) - 2 carrots,  
 unpeeled and chopped  
 1 tbsp minced garlic (3 cloves)  
 - 4 lb vine-ripened tomatoes,  
 coarsely chopped (5 large) - 1 ½  
 tsps sugar - 1 tbsp tomato paste -  
 ¼ cup packed chopped fresh basil

leaves, plus julienned basil leaves, for garnish - 3  
 cups chicken stock - 1 tbsp kosher salt - 2 tsps freshly ground black pepper -  
 ¾ cup heavy cream - Croutons, for garnish

## Directions

Heat the olive oil in a large, heavy-bottomed pot over medium-low heat. Add the onions and carrots and sauté for about 10 minutes, until very tender. Add the garlic and cook for 1 minute. Add the tomatoes, sugar, tomato paste, basil, chicken stock, salt, and pepper and stir well. Bring the soup to a boil, lower the heat, and simmer, uncovered, for 30 to 40 minutes, until the tomatoes are very tender.

Add the cream to the soup and process it through a food mill into a bowl, discarding only the dry pulp that's left. Reheat the soup over low heat just until hot and serve with julienned basil leaves and/or croutons.

demonstration of **ePulse condition assessment trenchless technology**. The  
Division of Public Health's Drinking Water State Revolving Grant Fund  
provided a \$50,000 grant to New Castle City in support of the utilization of  
new technologies to assess its water infrastructure. New Castle City  
contracted with Echologics to use its ePulse technology to conduct acoustic  
leak detection and condition assessment. ePulse uses sound wave  
technology to deliver sound waves through pipelines in an effort to  
determine the presence of any leaks and pipe wall thickness.
