### this week in HISTORY

- **21** Old Ironsides, the Navy frigate Constitution, was launched. 1797, *Thomas Edison* invented the incandescent electric lamp. 1879, A Saturday Evening Post advertisement offered a chance to buy, for the first time, a two-sided record. 1908, Margaret Owen set a typing speed record of 170 words per minute. 1918, US Treasury Dept. announced that it had fined 29,620 people for (alcohol) prohibition violations. 1925, Chuck Berry's My Ding-A-Ling hit #1. 1972
- **22** This day is recognized as *The Great Disappointment* among those who practiced *Millerism*. 1844, First televised pro football game was telecast. *Brooklyn defeated Philadelphia 23-14*. 1939, *President Kennedy* went on radio and \*television to inform the United States about his order to send forces to blockade Cuba. 1962, *Joan Baez* received a gold record for her hit, \*The Night They Drove Old Dixie Down. 1971
- **23** Blanche S. Scott became the first woman to make a public solo airplane flight. 1910, Approximately 25,000 women demanded the right to vote with a march in NYC. 1915, J.K. Scott won the first miniature golf tournament. Don't think he was a midget though. 1930, Walt Disney's ◆Dumbo & Baby Mine were released. 1941, Dion's ◆ Runaround Sue was the #1 US single. 1961.
- **24** *Alonzo D. Phillips* received a patent for the phosphorous friction safety match. 1836, *Telegrams* were

### on the counter

3 pounds Granny Smith apples—peeled, cored and sliced into 1/4-inch wedges • 1/2 c. granulated sugar 3 tbsp all-purpose flour, plus more for dusting • Two 14-ounce packages all-butter puff pastry, chilled

### let's make pie

- In a large bowl, toss the apples with the sugar and the 3 tsp of flour.
- On a lightly floured work surface, roll out each piece of puff pastry to a 14-inch square. Ease one pastry square into a 9 1/2-inch deep glass pie plate. Scrape the apples and their juices into the shell. Lay the second layer of puff pastry on top. Press the edges together to seal and trim the overhang to 1 inch. Crimp the edge decoratively and cut a few slits on top for venting. Freeze the pie for 1 hour.
- Oven happy at 400°. Place the apple pie on a baking sheet and transfer it to the oven. Bake for 30 minutes, until the crust is lightly golden. Reduce the oven temperature to 375° and bake for 40 minutes longer, until the top is deep golden brown. Transfer the pie to a wire rack to cool slightly before serving. *Oh, gonna neeed vanilla ice cream too!*



This twist on a Gin Daisy looks coral in daylight and glows white under a black light.

3 oz. Gin
1/2 oz. lemon juice
1 tsp. grenadine
1 handful ice
tonic water

Mix gin, lemon juice and grenadine in a cocktail shaker; pour into a large glass filled with ice.

Top with tonic water. Garnish with a glow stick (optional).




