22 This day is recognized as **The Great Disappointment** among those who practiced **Millerism**. 1844, First televised pro football game was telecast. **Brooklyn defeated Philadelphia 23-14**. 1939, **President Kennedy** went on radio and **television** to inform the United States about his order to send forces to blockade Cuba. 1962, **Joan Baez** received a gold record for her hit, **The Night They Drove Old Dixie Down**. 1971

23 **Blanche S. Scott** became the first woman to make a public solo airplane flight. 1910, Approximately **25,000 women** demanded the right to vote with a march in NYC. 1915, **J.K. Scott** won the first miniature golf tournament. Don't think he was a midget though. 1930, **Walt Disney's Dumbo & Baby Mine** were released. 1941, **Dion's Runaround Sue** was the #1 US single. 1961.

24 **Alonzo D. From the News Journal on Sunday Oct. 15

"By using innovative construction practices we are able to complete projects faster, safer, and more efficiently. For example, on Tuesday, we completely closed the heavily traveled Del. 141 bridge over U.S. 13 for a badly needed deck replacement project. If we approached this project as we have in the past, such as just closing one lane or direction at a time, this project would take 6 to 7 months to complete using traditional methods.

However, by taking a new approach to this project, we will close the entire bridge to replace the severely worn concrete deck with precast panels joined using ultra-high performance concrete (UHPC). This method will allow us to complete a majority of the work in just 45 days and fully reopen the bridge to traffic in November."

EGGS goldenrod



YOU'LL NEED

- 4 hard-cooked eggs
- 2 tbsps butter
- 2 tbsps all-purpose flour
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 1/8 tsp pepper
- 1 cup milk
- 4 to 6 slices buttered toast, chopped or torn into bite-sized pieces, separated onto four serving plates.

✓ Peel eggs; separate whites from yolks. Chop whites into bite-sized pieces. In small bowl, mash yolks with fork or press through fine strainer. Set aside.

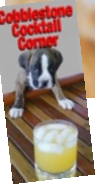
✓ In 1-quart heavy saucepan, melt butter over low heat. With whisk, beat in flour, salt and pepper. Cook over low heat, stirring until mixture is smooth and bubbly. Remove sauce from heat. Stir in milk.

✓ Return sauce to heat; heat to boiling, stirring constantly. Boil 1 minute or until sauce thickens slightly. Remove from heat. Fold chopped egg whites into white sauce.

✓ To serve, arrange buttered toast pieces on 4 serving plates. Pour creamed eggs over buttered toast pieces; sprinkle with yolks.

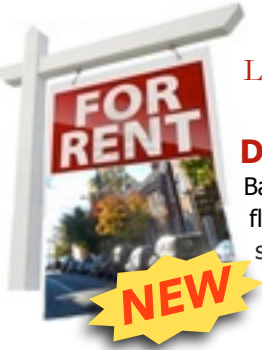
