A tower of history finds a new home at Bellanca field.

This beacon tower was recently installed at the Bellanca Field Museum. Harry Vanderhuval has loaned the circa 1930 tower that once stood at the Georgetown Air Park indefinitely. FOB (Friends of Bellanca) member Joe Finocchiaro restored and directed the installation. Trustee of the Common member Christopher Castagno

arranged for the crane with Becky Kendall of Raven Crane & Equipment to bring the assembled tower to its upright position.


The Whismans love dogs - especially rescue dogs.




