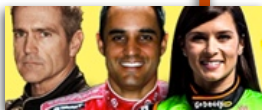

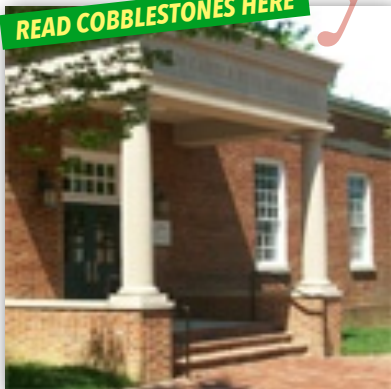

Simply **PUMPKIN** Pancakes

"Quick, easy, delicious pumpkin pancakes from scratch. Developed for my pumpkin-loving grandson who will eat almost anything containing pumpkin. Serve warm with butter and syrup."



INGREDIENTS

Change Servings

- ♦ 1 1/4 cs all-purpose flour
- ♦ 1/4 c white sugar
- ♦ 2 tsps baking powder
- ♦ 1/2 tsp ground cinnamon
- ♦ 1/4 tsp ground nutmeg
- ♦ 1 c milk
- ♦ 1/2 c pumpkin puree
- ♦ 1 egg, beaten
- ♦ 1 tbsp vegetable oil

DIRECTIONS

- 🔥 Sift flour, sugar, baking powder, cinnamon, and nutmeg together in a bowl.
- 🔥 Whisk milk, pumpkin, egg, and oil together in a bowl. Pour milk mixture into flour mixture and stir until just moistened. Batter will be slightly lumpy.
- 🔥 Heat a lightly oiled griddle over medium-high heat to 350°
- 🔥 Drop batter by large spoonfuls onto the griddle and cook until bubbles form and the edges are dry, 1 to 3 minutes. Flip and cook until browned on the other side, about 1 minute more. Repeat with remaining batter.

chestnuts

add a sweet, meaty taste to stuffing and stews.

Here's how to peel a chestnut without cutting off your thumb!



Make an X on the flat side of the shells with a sharp knife. Wear leather gloves, because the nuts are slippery. Place the nuts in a single layer in a glass baking dish, cover with waxed paper, and

microwave on High for about 6 minutes, until the shells begin to peel back.

While the nuts are still warm, use a small sharp knife to peel off the shells and as much of the inner brown skins as you can. Work patiently to avoid bloodshed (your own). Before adding the nuts to stuffing or other dishes, sauté them in 1 tablespoon butter until golden brown

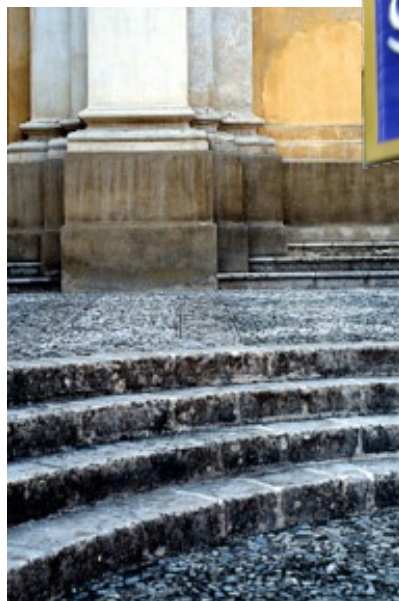
