



### MY GRAMMIES Delaware Relish

1 quart green tomatoes
2 quarts cabbage
5 medium sized onions
6 red peppers
1 quart vinegar
1/2 tblspn celery seed
3/4 tblspn mustard seed
1/2 tblspn allspice (ground)
2 tblspn salt
2/3 tblspn turmeric
1 cup sugar

Slice the tomatoes and let them stand overnight in salted water. In the morning drain thoroughly.

Chop fine the onions, peppers, tomatoes. Cabbage my shredded fine or chopped.

Put vinegar in the pressuring kettle, add sugar, spices and turmeric, then the vegetable mixture and scald thoroughly. Put in small jars with vegetable juice.

Thank you to Viridian Energy who was the spear head of the project as well as William Penn High School's junior ROTC program.




Problems fell the stately Elm




