## Parking lot approved, conditionally.

Last Monday evening the three member Board of Adjustment approved the controversial Battery Park parking lot behind M&T Bank with some conditions. Board of Adjustment consists of Mayor Jimmy Gama-corta, the City Solicitor, Daniel Losco, and the City Engineer, Dave Athey. Earlier in the evening Drew Hayes of ForeSite Associates, Inc, presented an hour plus overview of the project while answering the Board's questions. After a brief respite, the public aired their pros and cons. The cons out-weighed those in favor. Mayor Gambacorta made it clear he was against the parking lot, "taking a chunk out of our pristine Battery Park...NO". Losco and Athey began discussing conditions which became; downsizing from 42 to 32 spaces. The Trustees would be perpetually responsible for security cameras and landscaping. Four spaces would be removed from the 3rd Street property lines. Construction would be completed 2 years after a non-appealable Board of Adjustment decision. The next step, the Trustees must submit an application for a building permit to the Building Official, who will issue the permit as a matter of course so long as the construction plans submitted by the Trustees meet building code requirements. The permitting process will include review and approval by the New Castle Conservation District as to storm water runoff issues and a final review by the Planning Commission to ensure that the requirements imposed by the Historic Area Commission and the Board of Adjustment are being satisfied. Once this is done, a building permit would be issued and the Trustees could commence construction.

# MINI PECAN PUMPKIN PIES



## GONNA NEED

Nonstick cooking spray

## FOR THE DOUGH

1/4 cup pecans - 1/4 cup sugar ■ 1/2 tsp salt ■ 3/4 cups all purpose flour, plus extra for shaping dough ■ 6 tbsp butter, ice-cold ■ 2 to 3 tbsp ice water

## FOR THE FILLING

1 egg, plus 1 egg yolk ■ 1/2 cup dark corn syrup ■ 1 tbsp sugar ■ 1/2 cup canned pumpkin pie filling ■ 1 tsp vanilla ■ 1/4 cup pecans, chopped plus 24 halves for garnish ■ 2 (12-cup) mini muffin tins

## GET COOKN'

Make oven happy at oven to 350°

Spray the bottoms and sides of the muffin tins with cooking spray.

## FOR THE DOUGH

In a food processor, pulse the pecans, sugar, salt, and flour, until the nuts are ground and the ingredients are combined. Add in the butter and pulse until dough resembles coarse meal. Slowly pour in the ice water through the feed tube until the dough comes together. Remove from processor bowl to a clean work surface sprinkled with flour. Form the dough into a ball and divide evenly into 24 pieces. Roll each piece into a ball and evenly press into each cup, until the bottom is covered. If the dough is sticky, dip your finger in flour first. Bake until the crusts are very golden, 15 to 18 minutes. Check periodically to make sure they don't get too brown. Meanwhile...

**MAKE THE FILLING** In a medium bowl, whisk the egg yolk, corn syrup, sugar, pumpkin filling and vanilla. Stir in the chopped pecans. Remove the dough from the oven and spoon 1 tablespoon of the filling into each cup. Top each with 1 pretty pecan half. Return the pans to the oven and continue baking, for 12 to 15 minutes more, until the pumpkin filling is set. Allow to cool before removing from the pans. [Watch how to make this recipe.](#)
