

Senator Connor was instrumental in obtaining state funding for our recent library expansion and renovation in addition to restoration of state buildings on the Green in New Castle.


She is a long-time supporter for our community and its citizens and has worked tirelessly to serve her constituents. She was always proud to be our partner . . . and voice in Dover.

ingredients

- * 1 loaf French bread (13 to 16 ounces)
- ★ 8 large eggs
- ★ 2 cups half-and-half
- * 1 cup milk
- * 2 tablespoons granulated sugar
- * 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- * 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- * 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- ∗ Dash salt
- * Praline Topping, recipe follows
- ✤ Maple syrup

directions

Slice French bread into 20 slices, 1-inch each. (Use any extra bread for garlic toast or bread crumbs). Arrange slices in a generously buttered 9 by 13-inch flat baking dish in 2 rows, overlapping the slices. In a large bowl, combine the eggs, halfand-half, milk, sugar, vanilla, cinnamon, nutmeg and salt and beat with a rotary beater or whisk until blended but not too bubbly. Pour mixture over the bread slices, making sure all are covered evenly with the milk-egg mixture. Spoon some of the mixture in between the slices. Cover with foil and refrigerate overnight. **The next day**, preheat oven to 350° F. Spread Praline Topping evenly over the bread and bake for 40 minutes, until puffed and lightly golden. Serve with maple syrup.

praline topping:

- * 1/2 pound (2 sticks) butter
- * 1 cup packed light brown sugar
- * 1 cup chopped pecans
- * 2 tablespoons light corn syrup
- * 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- * 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg




