5-lb. beef tenderloin or

cut of beef of your choice This ya gotta marinate with 11/4 cups port wine (or other sweet wine or ½ cup red wine vinegar plus ½ cup water plus ¼ cup sugar)

½ cup olive oil

Grilled Marinated Beef Tenderloin

Go ahead and brush off the snow and fire up the

1/4 cup fresh lemon juice (juice of 1 lemon)

¼ cup Worcestershire sauce ◆ ¼ cup water 1 tsp. freshly ground pepper • ½ tsp. cayenne pepper 1 tsp. thyme ♦ 4 cloves minced garlic ♦ 2 whole bay leaves

Rinse the meat and pat dry. Place in a shallow dish. In a bowl, combine the marinade ingredients and mix well. Reserve 1 cup of the marinade separately for basting/sauce making. Pour the remaining marinade over the beef, turning to coat. Cover and refrigerate overnight, or at least a few hours.

Remove from the marinade. Grill over medium heat and baste with 114 cup reserved marinade as needed. Grill to your desired level of doneness. Our 5-lb. tenderloin done to medium-rare took about 25 minutes. Put the other % cup reserved marinade in a small pan and boil until reduced by half. Serve with the tenderloin.
