18 The first **orthopedic hospital** was organized in NYC. It was called the *Hospital for Ruptured and Crippled*. 1862, **Slavery was abolished** with the 13th Amendment to the Constitution being ratified. 1865, A new **automobile speed record** was set at 39 mph. 1898, WPTZ in Plattsburgh, NY, presented a Felso commercial, marking **the first color telecast** seen on a local station. **What's Felso?** Felso was a laundry detergent. 1953

19 **Robinson Crusoe** leaves his island after 28 years. 1686, **Benjamin Franklin** began publishing *Poor Richard's Almanac*. 1732, **Gen. George Washington** led his army of about 11,000 men to Valley Forge, PA, to camp for the winter. 1777, A *Christmas Carol* by **Charles Dickens** was published in London and immediately sold out. 1843, Corrugated paper was patented by **Albert L. Jones**. 1871, **Robert Ripley** began his *Believe It or Not* column. 1918, **Neil Sedaka's** *Calendar Girl* was released 1960,

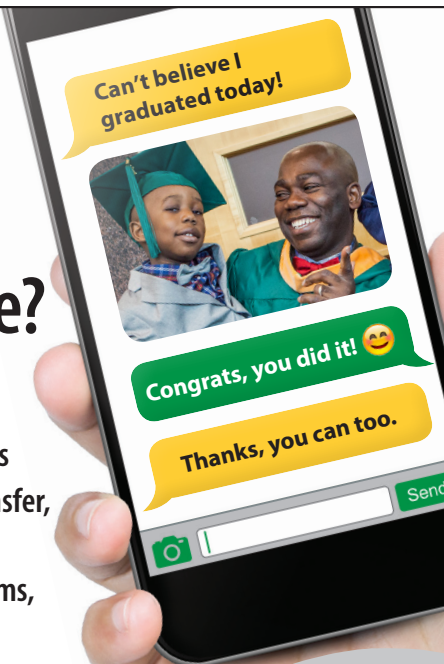

english rib roast



- 1/3 cup finely ground coffee
- 2 tablespoons kosher salt
- 1 tablespoon freshly ground black pepper
- 1/4 vanilla bean, split and seeds scraped
- 1 12lb bone-in prime rib roast (5 bones)

- 1 In a bowl, thoroughly blend the coffee with the salt, pepper and vanilla bean seeds. Set the rib roast in a roasting pan and rub it all over with the coffee mixture, concentrating most of the rub on the fatty part of the meat. Turn the roast bone side down and let stand at room temperature for 30 minutes.
- 2 Preheat the oven to 450°. Roast the meat for 15 minutes. Reduce the oven temperature to 325° and roast for about 2 1/2 hours longer, until an instant-read thermometer inserted in the thickest part of the meat registers 125° for medium-rare.
- 3 Transfer the roast to a carving board and let rest for 20 minutes. Scrape off any excess coffee rub. Carve the meat in 1/2-inch-thick slices and serve. The coffee-rubbed roast can be refrigerated overnight. Bring to room temperature before roasting.

ingredients

- 6 eggs, separated • .75cp sugar
- 1qt whole milk • 1pt heavy cream
- 8oz bourbon • 4oz Spiced rum

garnish: 1 grated nutmeg
the makin'

In a large bowl, beat together the egg yolks and half a cup of sugar until they turn light in color.

Stir in the milk, heavy cream, bourbon and rum.

In a separate bowl, beat the egg whites with the remaining quarter-cup of sugar until they form soft peaks.

Fold about a third of the egg whites into the yolk mixture.

Serve in punch or tea cups topped with freshly grated nutmeg, folding in more of the egg whites as desired.

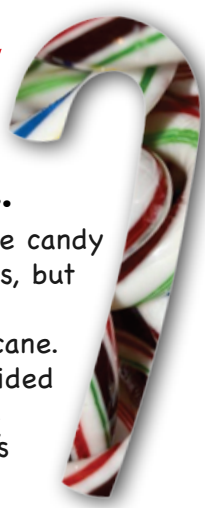

One candy cane each for 1.76 billion people.

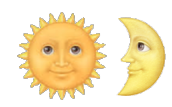


The classic peppermint flavor of the candy cane has been around for 600 years, but the original candy canes were just straight sticks, like a real walking cane. In 1640, a German choirmaster decided to change things up by curving the shape to look more like a shepherd's staff, resulting in the candy cane shape we all know and love today. Each year about 1.76 billion candy canes are made and 90% of candy canes are sold between Thanksgiving and Christmas. In fact, candy canes are the number one selling non-chocolate candy in the month of December. The biggest single week for candy cane sales is the second week in December; my guess is people stock up on them before Christmas to decorate their tree, bring to parties, and pack as snacks. Since each candy cane has only 55 calories and no fat it's actually a fairly "safe" holiday treat!
