

26 The Pilgrims landed at New Plymouth, to found Plymouth Colony, with John Carver as Governor. 1620, James Mason invents the coffee percolator. 1865, Marie and Pierre Curie discovered radium. 1898, A monster snowstorm hit NYC, dumping up to 26.4 inches of snow. 1947, Comedian Jack Benny died at age 80. 1974

27 *Dr. Crawford Williamson Long* used anesthesia for childbirth for the first time, when he delivered his own child. 1845, *Carrie Nation* staged her first raid on a saloon at the Carey Hotel in Wichita. 1900, *James Barrie's* play "*Peter Pan*" premiered in London. 1904, Radio City Music Hall opens. 1932, *Al Jolson* and actress *Ruby Keeler* were divorced after 12 years of marriage. 1940

28 The Pennsylvania Gazette, owned by **Benjamin** Franklin, ran an ad for the first issue of "Poor Richard's

Almanack." 1732, William F. Semple patented chewing gum. 1869, The first World Series of pro football was played. New York and Syracuse played in the indoor football game before 3,000. Syracuse, with Glen (Pop) Warner at guard, won 6-0 and went on to win the tournament. 1902, R.O. Sullivan crossed the Atlantic Ocean for the 100th time. 1942.

Regional NPS Director Gay Vietzke has named Cinda Waldbuesser as the new superintendent of First State National Historical Park in Delaware. Waldbuesser will begin her new assignment in January.

"Cinda combines a strong sense of the National Park Service mission with the knowledge and skills needed to shepherd this new national park through its early years of development." said Vietzke.

"I'm thrilled to return to First State to work with the park's wonderful staff and partners during this exciting time in the park's development," said Waldbuesser. "One of my top priorities is to move the rehabilitation of the Sheriff's House forward. This project will address critical deferred maintenance needs and also give the park its first visitor center to better serve visitors and more completely tell the park's important story." Waldbuesser comes to First State National Historical Park from the Interior Region 1 Office in Philadelphia. As chief of staff, she works closely with parks and regional staff on a wide range of issues. During her career with the NPS, she served as the region's partnership program coordinator where she oversaw the region's philanthropic and cooperating association programs. Prior to coming to the NPS, Waldbuesser worked on Capitol Hill, for a public affairs firm, ATIONAL and for a nonprofit park partner. Waldbuesser graduated from Cornell University with a degree in American Studies and completed graduate course

work at Duke University. She lives in



how to make super easy BEAR PAW COOKIES

These bear paw cookies are not just fun but SO easy! This is one of those things that make you go, why didn't I think of this sooner? All you really need is a basic sugar cookie recipe and some chocolate.

on the counter

3/4 C unsalted butter softened • 1 C sugar • 1/2 C light brown sugar • 1 egg + 1 egg yolk ● 1 tbsp vanilla extract ● 1 tsp baking soda ● 2 tsp cornstarch ● 1/2 tsp salt 2 C flour • 1 bag of ghiradelli dark chocolate melting wafers only need 24 wafer chips 1 bag of semi sweet chocolate chips only 3 chips go onto each cookie for the claws

let's make some

Oven happy at 350° • Line cookie sheet with parchment paper and set aside Using a stand mixer, cream together the butter, brown sugar and sugar until creamy• Add in the egg and egg yolk, vanilla and beat to combine. • Add in the baking soda, cornstarch, salt and flour and beat until a soft dough forms. • Using a small ice cream scoop, scoop dough into your hands and roll it ●iPlace dough onto cookie sheet and bake 9-12 minutes. • Once cookies are baked, place a melting wafer into the center of the cookie for the pad of the paw • Then place 3 chocolate chips above the paw for the claws • Repeat steps with remaining dough and cookies • Let cookies cool for about 30 minutes before enjoying!



Bring water to a boil in a medium saucepan. Once bubbling, stir in lime Jell-O, stirring until completely dissolved. Turn off heat. Pour in vodka or tequila (or whatever your preferred alcohol is), mixing until thoroughly combined.

 Pour into a large measuring cup, small pitcher or another glass so it's easier to pour into shot glasses. Pour Jell-O mixture into each shot glass. Place shot glasses into refrigerator until Jell-O sets, about 2 hours.

Garnish with whipped cream, mint leaves, and Red Hot candies before serving.




