

23 "A Visit from St. Nicholas" by Clement C. Moore was published. 1823, Following a quarrel with Paul Gauguin, **Vincent Van Gogh** cut off part of his own earlobe. 1888, **Bob Hope** agreed to entertain airmen in Alaska. It was the first of the traditional Christmas shows. 1942, The **transistor was invented** by physicists John Bardeen, Walter H. Brittain, and William Shockley. 1947, **Walt Disney's** classic movie, **20,000 Leagues Under the Sea**, was released. 1954

24 The **War of 1812** was ended with the signing of the Treaty of Ghent. 1814, **Franz Joseph Gruber** composed **Silent Night**. 1818, Fire devastated the **Library of Congress** destroying about 35,000 volumes. 1851, "Oh by gosh by golly!" Is it that time already? **R.H. Macy's** remained open until midnight for the first time. 1867, The first time, a **midnight Mass** was broadcast on television. 

breakfast sausage



These breakfast sausage patties are perfect for freezing, extra insurance toward future hangovers.
your gonna need

1 tbsp finely chopped fresh sage - 1 tbsp finely chopped fresh thyme - 2 tsps light brown sugar - 1½ tsps kosher salt - 1 tsp crushed fennel seeds - ½ tsp crushed red pepper flakes - ¼ tsp freshly ground black pepper - ¼ tsp garlic powder - ¼ tsp smoked paprika - 1 lb ground pork shoulder (Boston butt)

let's make some patties

Mix sage, thyme, brown sugar, salt, fennel seeds, red pepper flakes, black pepper, garlic powder, and paprika in a medium bowl. Add pork and work spice mixture into meat with your hands until it's very well blended.

Scoop out ¼-cupfuls of mixture and flatten into about ¼"-thick patties (they will plump slightly when cooled).

Griddle sausage over medium-high heat until browned on one side, about 2 minutes. Flip and cook 2 minutes more.

Patties can be made 2 days ahead. Stack between parchment paper; cover and chill, or freeze up to 1 month.

Negroni Sbagliato

750 ml Sweet vermouth
 750 ml Campari
 1 cup Assorted seasonal fruit
 750 ml Prosecco

Garnish: 1 Cinnamon

How to...

Add the sweet vermouth and Campari to a punch bowl and add large ice cubes or a large ice block.

Add the fruit and top with the prosecco.

Stir gently and garnish with freshly grated cinnamon.

Last Del. Wassam's closes doors

NEW CASTLE — It's the end of era.

The last Wassam's Variety Store — located at 308 Delaware Ave. — closed its doors Dec. 17.

"That's it. There will not be any more Wassam's in Delaware," said Mary Getz, a longtime employee. "The economy is so bad and competition is too great. We just couldn't compete with the other chains and their prices."

Tom O'Donnell, the former New Castle store manager, is trying to get financing to reopen the store under a new name, she said. "But

nothing's been approved ... no papers have been signed," Getz said.

Throughout the years, the five-store Wassam's chain had retained the charm of an old-fashioned five-and-dime. The variety stores have been a part of Delaware history for more than 35 years.

Company founder William M. Wassam didn't even have an adding machine when he opened his first store in Wilmington Manor in 1957. But the former Woolworth's store manager expanded his business to include stores in Chestnut Run, Polly Drummond and White Clay Shopping centers,

Elsmere and New Castle. When William Wassam retired last year, son John T. took over operations, Getz said.

Wassam's was the kind of place where a customer could buy hair nets, loose china, goldfish and doilies. During warm weather, a block of Delaware Avenue was gaily decorated with baskets of flowers from the store, which had been in operation for about 20 years.

"All the customers and all the people are sad when we closed ... We just cried and cried, but we just couldn't make it," Getz said.

Getz said declining sales and

competition had forced the closings of most of the Wassam's variety stores. The Polly Drummond site closed a year ago, and the 26-year-old Elsmere store on Sanders Avenue ceased operations in September.

Getz said the closing of the New Castle location marks the end of her 20-year employment as a buyer for Wassam's. "I have no idea what I'm going to do. I'm 60 years old, and there are not a lot of opportunities out there. I went on interviews, but nothing has come of them," Getz said.

The store's office at 1720 Faulkland Road will stay open until the end of January, she said.
